7 based upon the values of diversity and inclusion and has led the program to become the  
8 longest running and most successful Gay hoops program in the world, and

9 WHEREAS, Tony has encouraged the participation of hundreds of players of all skills,  
10 both men and women, and every race and creed, whether gay, straight or transgendered; and

11 WHEREAS, Tony has worked incredibly hard to ensure the success of the program by  
12 cultivating strong relationships with community groups, city officials, and members of the  
13 league; and

14 WHEREAS, Tony is an avid supporter of the Gay Games movement, and served as  
15 Treasurer and a Board Member of Team San Francisco and as a delegate to the International  
16 Federation of Gay Games; and

17 WHEREAS, The Chicago Hoops Classic Hall of Fame elected Tony as an inaugural  
18 member in 2000 in recognition of his exceptional contributions to the advancement of Gay  
19 basketball; and

20 WHEREAS, Tony is retiring as the head of the San Francisco Gay Basketball Program  
21 after the championship game on May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2006; now, therefore be it
