10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. Findings.

12 A. In conjunction with Ordinances [DPH] 204-10, and [DBI] 206-10 on  
13 file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File Nos. 100575, and 100577, this  
14 Ordinance amends Section 2.3.1 to extend to the entire Hunters Point Shipyard area special  
15 permit processing requirements that now apply at Hunters Point Shipyard Parcel A to address  
16 potential residual contamination.


17 B. In accordance with the actions contemplated herein, this Board adopted Resolution  
18 No. 347-10, concerning findings pursuant to the California Environmental Quality  
19 Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said Resolution is on file with  
20 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 100572 and is incorporated herein by  
21 reference.

22 Section 2. The San Francisco Public Works Code is hereby amended by amending  
23 Section 2.3.1 to read as follows:

1 **Sec. 2.3.1. Hunters Point Shipyard Permitting.**

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, applicants for any permit for Hunters  
3 Point Shipyard *Parcel A*, which involves *the subsurface* disturbance of *at least 50 cubic yards*  
4 *(38.23m<sup>3</sup>)* of soil or the extraction or management of groundwater, except *where such permit is*  
5 *for purposes of environmental characterization, and except, in the case of property determined by*  
6 *the applicable ROD to be suitable for unrestricted residential use, where such permit involves*  
7 *subsurface disturbance of less than 50 cubic yards (38.23m<sup>3</sup>) of soil*, shall comply with the  
8 requirements of Article 31 of the Health Code. Hunters Point Shipyard *Parcel A is that area -is*  
9 *that area* of the City and County of San Francisco shown on Figure 1-1 ~~Article 31 Map -~~  
10 Figure 1, which is maintained for public distribution by the Director. A copy of said figure is on  
11 file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. *041538* 100576.


