4	resolutions of necessity for proposed general obligation bonds must be introduced at

6	would consider the proposed bond measure, rather than 169 days before the election.

9	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
10	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
11 12	Section 2.31, to read as follows:
13	Sec. 2.31. PROPOSAL TO BE IN FORM OF RESOLUTION, DRAFTING,
14	CONTENTS, INTRODUCTION TO BOARD AND REFERRAL TO COMMITTEE.
15	The proposal provided for by Section 2.30 of this Code must be introduced by the
16	Mayor or by a member of the Board of Supervisors at a regular meeting of the Board in the
17	form of a resolution determining that the public interest or necessity demands the acquisition,
18	construction or completion of any municipal improvement.
19	Such resolution must be so introduced not less than $\frac{169}{168}$ days before the election a
20	which such proposal is to be acted upon by the voters. Upon introduction, such resolution
21	shall be referred to a committee of the Board of Supervisors.
