I would like the following 150-word comment to be included in the minutes for today's meeting regarding agenda item #2 (220739: "[Urging the Department of Public Health, Municipal Transportation Agency, and Police Department to Amend the City's Vision Zero Traffic Fatality Protocol]"):

Our city faces a crisis of car-related fatalities and serious injuries, and this resolution and its recommendations will help increase transparency on traffic fatalities and elevate the severity of this crisis facing our city.

With car-related fatalities continuing steadily since we committed to zero car-related fatalities by 2024, we need every possible tool deployed to address this crisis, raise awareness about it, and increase public engagement in the process to make our streets safer for our most-vulnerable street users.

I urge you to support Supervisor Preston, Mar, and Walton's resolution, while pushing for as much transparency and public awareness following a fatality caused by car traffic, including a joint report by all departments. I also urge all of you to support reducing driving lanes and free on-street private property storage in order to address this urgent crisis.
