Matt Shelton on behalf of the Shelton Theatre has filed an application with the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control seeking a Type 64 (On-Sale General Theatre) license for 533 Sutter Street. This original application will take over the current license, Type 42 (On-Sale Beer and Wine Public Premise), for which the Board passed the resolution on September 22, 2009.

The change in the type will allow the Shelton Theatre to serve distilled spirits. None of the conditions originally placed on the premises will change.

It should be noted that during the application process, notification date for the 500' mailer was on August 20, 2014. The Notice to the Public was posted on August 19, 2014.
