10 WHEREAS, BALIF members build coalitions with other legal organizations to combat
11 all forms of discrimination; and,

12 WHEREAS, BALIF volunteers are actively involved in filing amicus briefs in court
13 cases of interest to the LGBT community; and,

14 WHEREAS, The organization also promotes the appointment of lesbian, gay, bisexual
15 and transgender attorneys to the judiciary and public agencies and commissions; and,

16 WHEREAS, BALIF board members have been appointed to high posts in the Clinton
17 Administration as well as at the state and local levels; and,

18 WHEREAS, BALIF is currently celebrating 20 years of service in San Francisco in an
19 event on March 30, 2000, featuring Clinton Administration appointee Todd Dickinson and
20 honoring Assemblywoman Carole Migden and Assemblywoman Sheila Kuehl; now, therefore,
