WHEREAS, On August 10, 1999, a man armed with an automatic weapon opened fire at the North Valley Jewish Community Center in Los Angeles County, wounding three children, a teenager and an adult in an apparent act of antisemitic violence; and,

WHEREAS, The suspect charged with the shooting then allegedly murdered a postal worker because of his race; and,

WHEREAS, The suspect has alleged to suggest that his murderous behavior was intended to incite additional antisemitic and racist violence; and,

WHEREAS, Such hate crimes are often perpetrated by individuals taught violence and intolerance during their formative years; and,

WHEREAS, Teaching children to appreciate diversity helps build a more productive and compassionate society;" now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors condemns the hatemotivated violence perpetrated at the Jewish Community Center in Los Angeles on August 10, 1999; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges all Americans to respect and value diversity and to instill compassion among our children.
