

1 [Resolution authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works to accept and expend
2 federal grant funds totaling \$6,110,000 for the SOMA Pavement Renovation Project and the
3 Cortland Avenue Pavement Renovation Project.]

4 **Resolution authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works to accept and**
5 **expend federal Surfacing Transportation Program funds totaling \$6,110,000 for the**
6 **SOMA Pavement Renovation Project and the Cortland Avenue Pavement Renovation**
7 **Project.**

9 WHEREAS, The Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A
10 Legacy for Users (SAFETEA) continues the Surface Transportation Program (STP) and the
11 Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ); and,

12 WHEREAS, SAFETEA legislation will guide STP, CMAQ, and Transportation
13 Enhancements programming until a SAFETEA bill is authorized; and,

14 WHEREAS, Pursuant to SAFETEA, and the regulations promulgated thereunder,
15 eligible project sponsors wishing to receive STP or CMAQ grants for a project shall submit an
16 application first with the appropriate metropolitan transportation planning organization (MPO),
17 for review and inclusion in the MPO's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and,

18 WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission is the MPO for the San
19 Francisco Bay region; and,

20 WHEREAS, DPW is an eligible project sponsor for STP or CMAQ funds; and

21 WHEREAS, DPW is an eligible sponsor of projects in the State Transportation
22 Improvement Program; and

23 WHEREAS, DPW is authorized to submit an application for State Transportation
24 Improvement Program funds for the SOMA Pavement Renovation Project and the Cortland

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1 Avenue Pavement Renovation Project; and

2 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority, on behalf of the City
3 and County of San Francisco, submitted an application to MTC for funds from the Federal
4 Third Cycle STP Improvement Program in Fiscal Years 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 for the
5 following projects: \$4,860,000 for the SOMA Pavement Renovation Project and \$1,250,000
6 for the Cortland Avenue Pavement Renovation Project, or a total of \$6,110,000; and,

7 WHEREAS, The federal funding will cover 88.5 percent of eligible costs up to total
8 project costs as defined by the Federal Highway Administration and administered by Caltrans;
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, The non-federal share will be paid for with local half-cent sales tax
11 administered by the San Francisco County Transportation Authority; and,

12 WHEREAS, The non-federal share of the total costs of the projects is \$1,708,024
13 which is greater than the required 11.5 percent local match; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works understands that the total amount of STP
15 funding for the aforementioned projects is fixed at \$6,110,000, and that any cost increases
16 incurred by the Department in delivering these projects must be funded by local funds, and
17 that the Department of Public Works does not expect any cost increases to be funded with
18 STP funds; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works will complete the project as described in
20 the application and as programmed in MTC's TIP; and,

21 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works understands that funds must be
22 obligated by June 30 of the year that the projects are programmed for in the TIP, or the
23 projects may be removed from the program; and,

24 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works has a certified pavement management
25 system (PMS); and,

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1 WHEREAS, There is no legal impediment to the Department of Public Works making
2 applications for STP and Regional Improvement Program funds for the SOMA Pavement
3 Renovation Project and the Cortland Avenue Pavement Renovation Project; and,

4 WHEREAS, There is no pending or threatened litigation which might in any way
5 adversely affect the proposed projects, or the ability of the Department of Public Works to
6 deliver such projects; and,

7 WHEREAS, A copy of this resolution will be transmitted to the MTC in conjunction with
8 the filing of the application; therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Director of the
10 Department of Public Works to accept and expend \$6,110,000 in Federal Third Cycle STP
11 Improvement Program funds for Fiscal Years 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 for the SOMA
12 Pavement Renovation Project and the Cortland Avenue Pavement Renovation Project and to
13 execute all documents therefor.
