[Appointments, Committee on City Workforce Alignment - Ruth Barajas, Tiffany Jackson, and Bartolomy Pantoja]

Motion appointing Ruth Barajas (residency requirement waived), Tiffany Jackson (residency requirement waived), and Bartolomy Pantoja, terms expiring November 6, 2025, to the Committee on City Workforce Alignment.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person(s) to serve as member of the Committee on City Workforce Alignment, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Chapter 30, Article I, Section 30.5, for the term(s) specified:

Ruth Barajas (residency requirement waived) seat 15, inaugural appointment, shall be a member of the public who, at the time of their appointments are employed by Nonprofit Corporations that provide Workforce Development Services to low-income San Francisco residents and those with barriers to employment, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending November 6, 2025;

Tiffany Jackson (residency requirement waived), seat 16, inaugural appointment, shall be a member of the public who, at the time of their appointments are employed by Nonprofit Corporations that provide Workforce Development Services to low-income San Francisco residents and those with barriers to employment, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending November 6, 2025;

Bartolomy Pantoja, seat 17, inaugural appointment, shall be a member of the public who is affiliated with labor organization and has leadership experience and demonstrated expertise in workforce development systems, policies, and programs, including registered

- 1 apprenticeship programs, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending November 6,
- 2 2025; and, be it

- FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:
- 1. The membership of the Committee on City Workforce Alignment has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
 - 2. Applicants Ruth Barajas and Tiffany Jackson, who are not residents of San Francisco, are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Committee on City Workforce Alignment.
 - 3. The Committee on City Workforce Alignment has attempted to fill the positions, for which Ruth Barajas and Tiffany Jackson were nominated, with individuals who are City residents and who have the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Ruth Barajas and Tiffany Jackson, are qualified to serve on the Committee on City Workforce Alignment.
 - 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no other possible representatives who are residents of San Francisco, who have the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and who are willing to serve on the Committee on City Workforce Alignment at this time; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Ruth Barajas and Tiffany Jackson, as is allowed in cases where no qualified City residents who are willing to serve can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that otherwise requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
