3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks"**
4 **by adding thereto Section 1550 to change the official sidewalk width on the west side**
5 **of Mission Street from 16th Street southerly, near the southwesterly corner of 16th and**
6 **Mission Streets; making findings pursuant to Planning Code Section 101.1; and**
7 **requiring relocation, modification, or both of facilities affected by the sidewalk width**
8 **changes.**

13 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference
15 herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter
16 dated March 23,2001, which stated that the actions contemplated herein are consistent with
17 the General Plan and Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of such
18 letter is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 020180.

19 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. 172,912, a
20 copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 020180, Board of
21 Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks," a copy of
22 which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May
23 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

24 Section 1550. The width of sidewalk on the west side of Mission Street from 16th Street
25 southerly, near the southwesterly corner of 16th and Mission Streets, shall be modified as shown on


1 Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-540, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of
2 Supervisors File No. 020180

3 Section 3. The Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART), the project sponsor who
4 proposes to undertake the sidewalk construction to implement the sidewalk width changes, is
5 required to make arrangements with public utilities and City Departments concerning
6 relocation, modification, or both of facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas. Any
7 necessary relocation, modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and
8 County of San Francisco.




