**SUBJECT: Retroactive Accept and Expend California Department of Parks  
and Recreation Recreational Infrastructure Revenue  
Enhancement Grant and Contract Approval for the Crocker  
Amazon Playground and Lake Merced Trail Improvements in  
the amount of \$1,634,450**

The San Francisco Recreation and Park Department (RPD) will be entering into a grant contract with the California State Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) in December 2021 to receive \$1,634,450 in Recreational Infrastructure Revenue Enhancement (RIRE) Grant funds.

RPD is seeking the Board of Supervisors approval to accept and expend the grant funds and enter into the agreement prior to taking these actions.

The retroactive nature of this legislation is due to DPR's policy to back date the RIRE grant contract start dates to the beginning of Fiscal Year 2019-2020, the fiscal year in which the funding was appropriated in the State Budget.

Therefore, the RIRE grant performance period and the grant contract period commenced on July 1, 2019, making the contract retroactive.
