3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Children, Youth, and Families to retroactively**
4 **accept and expend grant funding in the amount of \$23,000 from the California**
5 **Department of Public Health to fund a collaborative project with the San Francisco**
6 **Unified School District to develop a policy related to the joint use of school district**
7 **facilities that will benefit the school district, city, and community by increasing access**
8 **to space where educational, health, social services, sports, recreation, and other**
9 **activities can be provided for the period of September 15, 2010, through January 31,**
10 **2012.**

12 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco was awarded a grant on
13 September 10, 2010 in the amount of \$23,000 from the California Department of Health
14 to fund a collaborative project with San Francisco Unified School District to develop a policy
15 related to the joint use of school district facilities that will benefit the school district, city and
16 community by increasing access to space where educational, health, social services, sports,
17 recreation and other activities; and

18 WHEREAS, Policies that allow joint use of school facilities during out of school time
19 have been shown to help meet community needs and optimize public resources in other
20 communities across the country; and

21 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District has partnered with the
22 Department of Children, Youth & Their Families on this issue for the last year and half through
23 a process that involved community stakeholders and resulted in documentation of existing
24 procedures; and

25 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District will collaborate with the

1 Department of Children, Youth & Their Families on this grant-funded project; and,

2 WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth & Their Families will submit all
3 fiscal and programmatic reports to the California Department of Public Health in FY 2010-
4 2011 and FY 2011-2012; and,


5 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

6 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds
7 on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now
8 therefore be it

9 RESOLVED, That the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families is
10 hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant from the California
11 Department of Public Health in the amount of \$23,000 from September 15, 2010 through
12 January 31, 2012; and therefore be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
14 indirect costs in the grant budget.
