2 **AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**  
3 **OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS**  
4 **NECESSARY TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND \$546,940 OF TRANSPORTATION**  
5 **DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA) ARTICLE 3 FUNDS FOR BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN**  
6 **PROJECTS FOR FY 2000-01.**

7 WHEREAS, Article 3 of the Transportation Development Act (TDA),  
8 as amended (Pub. Util. Code Secs. 99233.3 and 99234), provides for  
9 the disbursement of funds in the nine-county Metropolitan  
10 Transportation Commission region for bicycle and pedestrian purposes;

11 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works has identified \$273,470  
12 of work to improve access for persons with disabilities by  
13 construction or reconstruction of curb ramps at various locations in  
14 the City; and,

15 WHEREAS, the Department of Parking and Traffic has identified  
16 \$273,470 of work for various bicycle projects and programs; and,

17 WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible according to State of  
18 California rules and regulations; and,

19 WHEREAS, pursuant to TDA Article 3, as amended, and pursuant to  
20 the applicable rules and regulations thereunder (21 CA Admin Code  
21 6600 et.seq.), a prospective claimant wishing to receive an  
22 allocation must file its claim with the Metropolitan Transportation  
23 Commission; and,

24 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works will require \$273,740 to  
25 construct new curb ramps and to reconstruct certain curb ramps to


1 make them fully compliant with the federal American with Disabilities  
2 Act; and,

3 WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission adopted Resolution  
4 No. 110-00-PTC at its March 21, 2000 meeting authorizing the  
5 Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic to  
6 execute documents necessary to apply for, accept, and expend up to  
7 \$327,439 of FY 2000-01 TDA Article 3 funds for various bicycle  
8 projects and programs; and,

9 WHEREAS, DPT has adjusted its project budget to reflect the  
10 reduced amount of funding available; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize  
12 the Director of Public Works to accept and expend \$546,940 in  
13 Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 Funds for bicycle and  
14 pedestrian projects for FY 2000-01 and to execute any and all  
15 documents necessary therefore.




