Resolution recognizing April 2024 as "National Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention Month" in the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, Sexual violence remains a pervasive and urgent public health issue affecting individuals of all ages, genders, and backgrounds across the United States; and

WHEREAS, According to the United States Department of Justice and the Department of Health and Human Services, an estimated 410,532 individuals in the United States experienced sexual violence in 2023; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Health and Human Services' 2023 Child

Maltreatment Report substantiated 60,273 cases of sexual abuse of children under 18

years of age; and

WHEREAS, The alarming frequency of sexual assaults, with someone being sexually assaulted every 72 seconds according to the Rape, Abuse & Incest National Network (RAINN), underscores the pressing need for sustained efforts in prevention, intervention, and support services for survivors; and

WHEREAS, Despite this prevalence, a significant number of cases go unreported, exacerbating the barriers survivors face in obtaining justice, including significant gaps in arrest, prosecution, and conviction rates; and

WHEREAS, The National Sexual Violence Resource Center (NSVRC) highlights that over half of female rape victims report being assaulted by an intimate partner, exposing the pervasive nature of domestic sexual violence within our communities; and

WHEREAS, RAINN indicates that 54% of sexual assaults occur in or near the victim's home, emphasizing the critical importance of creating safe environments within personal spaces and communities; and

WHEREAS, Sexual assault disproportionately affects certain populations, such as American Indians and Alaska Natives, who experience significantly higher rates of victimization, underscoring the need for culturally sensitive and inclusive support services; and

WHEREAS, The aftermath of sexual assault can lead to severe consequences, including post-traumatic stress disorder, substance abuse, depression, homelessness, and suicidal ideation, as outlined by the National Alliance to End Sexual Violence; and

WHEREAS, Collaborations among various agencies and professionals, including law enforcement, healthcare providers, educators, and victim support services, are crucial in addressing and combating sexual violence; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors is steadfast in its commitment to raising awareness, preventing, and deterring sexual violence in the community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors officially recognizes

April 2024 as National Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention Month.
