Honorable Supervisors,

The Neighborhood Business Alliance is born out of decades of merchant organizing in the Arab, African, South Asian and minority-owned retailer communities in the Bay Area. The Arab American Grocers Association formed the Independent Grocers Association and the Tenderloin Merchants in the 1990s. Today, our Tenderloin-based merchants have been battling the severe conditions on the streets and continue to serve the public, keeping business open in equity neighborhoods. During the COVID-19 shutdowns, our sector was met with SFPD shutting stores down by Mayoral Health Order without prior notice. During the Health Crisis, we activated strong mutual-aid and free produce efforts that reinforced the bridge between corner markets and residents. We ask now, considering the proposed legislation to limit business hours, the sector is approached as a partner in bettering our neighborhoods and will be met with goodwill. The systemic forces that create poverty on our streets are reflective of the systemic barriers facing the urban retail sector and the communities supported by them, and we must address this change wholesomely.

We are willing to support necessary change to conditions in the Tenderloin, as proposed by this legislation, contingent upon the following:

- If private, individual small businesses are to take losses in the form of jobs and revenue, tangible mitigation must be considered as part of this proposal (i.e. financial mitigation in the form of fee reduction, priority permitting for change of use, accessory use etc.)
- Binding language or agreements that ensure transparency and accountability to the street cleaning services meant to serve storefronts, by the City, the Community Benefit Districts or any other intermediary contractors
- 1 year Pilot, with a 6-month Assessment which includes Data and reporting metrics on the efficacy of Pilot
- Pathway for compliant businesses (with or without ABC license, to be able to open until 2AM within proposed pilot period
- Remove the "Private Right to Sue" Clause

Outreach in-language and with a fair implementation and notice of violation procedure should be the baseline and we do not consider to be an added compromise. This sector takes the brunt of the cost in paying for our City's environmental policies through mandatory existing regulations; i.e. Cans and Bottles CRV redemption and collection fees and Cigarette Litter Abatement Fees which account for 5% of the entire budget being paid for by less than 700 small retailers. We have seen nuisance abatement codes that were meant to be pilots, continue decades without

reassessment or accountability. While we are adding an additional layer of regulatory compliance for this business community, we ask that the Board and Mayor consider removing any other duplicative codes that have rendered themselves unenforceable etc. to streamline the compliance burden for retailers (i.e. see <u>Economic Mitigation Working Group (EMWG)</u> Recommendations and Resolution).

As a result of disproportionate fees and restrictions on our sector, we are asking for increased resources to meet these increased regulations as a pretense for support of this legislation.

Dear Supervisors,

On behalf of many residents, working people, and business owners in the Tenderloin community, we urge you to support Mayor Breed's proposed two-year pilot program that would prohibit retail food and tobacco establishments in the 'Tenderloin Public Safety Area' from being open to the public during restricted hours, from 12:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Over the last few years, we have witnessed a proliferation of Tobacco Paraphernalia Establishments and corner shops over various blocks of the Tenderloin – sometimes between two to four per block – that have also increasingly extended their retail hours 24/7. While SFPD and law enforcement have made notable progress in closing the open-air drug market on the sidewalks during the daytime, families, seniors, working people, and business owners continue to express concern towards the conditions between late night and early morning.

Gathering and congregating in the proximity of retail businesses selling prepackaged food and tobacco products, fences, users, and dealers engage in illegal vending, drug use, and drug sales, until the early hours of the morning. Leaving behind trash, human waste, used needles, and sometimes even bullet casings in their wake, service workers and residents are confronted with threats to their health and safety.

Finding the rate of narcotic offenses and serious crimes – shootings, assaults, homocide, rape, and robberies – to be significanlty higher between 12:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. in the 'Tenderloin Public Safety Area,' the Police Department's analysis of 2023 incident reports speaks on the dangerous environment that residents and working people are forced to endure. In fact, many

simply refuse to venture out into certain parts of the neighborhood when the sun goes down if they can help it. Unable to walk their dogs, go for a run, or enjoy eating out at a restaurant in the neighborhood after sunset without feelings of fear or insecurity, seniors and families must resign to their homes. Looking at the Tenderloin as an ecosystem, retail stores, whether knowingly or not, facilitate unlawful night markets by providing cheap goods, lighted gathering points, and cover from officers should they need it.

Though the street-level, open-air drug market that plagues Tenderloin neighborhoods cannot be eliminated through one strategy alone, Mayor Breed's proposed Tenderloin Retail Hours Restriction Pilot Program was called for by the community and is supported by the community.

Good afternoon, Madam Chair, Supervisor Peskins and Supervisor Preston.

My name is Gregg Johnson and for the past several years I have worked side by side with many individuals who make up the Tenderloin. Being a 5th generation member of a proud family who has not only worked for this city, but my grandmother turned away nobody because of a lack of money. My values are rooted in this history and today is no different. We have heard from members of the community and business owners. It would seem that everyone has a dog in this fight. This is what I know.

It has taken aggressive action and the knowledge of Federal, State, and local officials to bring pressure to bear upon open air drug sales and usage in the Tenderloin. We were told more than a year ago that we cannot expect to see results overnight. But standing here today, I am telling this committee that we can see NOW what did could not then. There is not one person in this room who will publicly admit that they condone the violence we have seen in the Tenderloin. Likewise, there is no law-abiding citizen here who will admit that they feel safe walking the streets of TL from 12midnight to 5am. And if my grandmother were standing here, she would say that it's the devil's time.

I escorted my dad's sister to an old haunt she loves (the Black Cat) a couple weekends ago – she lives in Bayview and retired from Emporiums when it closed. Sunday morning, we went to Glide. This committee has a letter from her. I told her that we are working to change not simply the image or perception of the Tenderloin but to let everyone know that we are not only here, but we are open for business. I'm here today to say that I am aware of the amount of federal and state money that is received into and being spent within this neighborhood. I have been researching it for a long time and while it is not part of this statement today, I will say that I do not believe that any business operating in the TL will go out of business by closing from 12 to 5am. I walk past street vendors because I am not going to support illegal activities. When I walk into a store to make a purchase, the last thing that I am expecting is to purchase a product that was stolen from Walgreens they did not completely remove the tag. The seller of that product to me is among this audience today. This is why I have not been back into your store.

How many of us, did not think we would see a major improvement in open air drug sales? It did not happen overnight, and the plan of the mayor should be allowed to be put in place, tweaked, take hold, while we support, comment, and offer suggestions on ways to improve. This is not an unreasonable request but a way of being a sense of normalcy back to a neighborhood that has gone too far long without it. None of us can turn back the hands of time to 50 years ago but know that the next 50 will rest squarely on the shoulders of those who will not come to grips with reality and stop putting profits over public safety. My grandmother would tell me, if you are not apart of the solution – you must be a part of the problem.

I grew up in the Hunter's Point/Bayview area and spent many nights listening to jazz in either the Fillmore or the Tenderloin. My in-laws were partners in the Black Cat from 1955 to 1963. My brother's son returned here in 2017 after a career with Exxon Oil Company. Between 1996 and 2000, my brothers, sisters, nephews and nieces, cousins and grand children sold their property in San Francisco and moved to Richmond, Vallejo, and Vacaville where they purchased homes in sub-divisions. My oldest brother served this city as a DPW worker for more than 30 years and today several of my nephews work for the city.

This past weekend was the first time in more than 20 years that I visited the Tenderloin with my nephew who talked me into making the excursion and I actually enjoyed myself. I spent a few moments talking to someone I thought had moved on, but she is a fighter and a good soul. The purpose for this letter is to let this commission know that the Tenderloin is worth saving. My nephew assured me that the Tenderloin is much safer today than 3 years ago and I did not believe him. We have lost so much of this city during the past decade and people like my nephew risk it all and I had to ask why. He said, "because it's worth saving for those who will come after me". So, because he showed me a lovely evening Saturday and took me to Sunday services at Glide I stand in support of him, his efforts and those he volunteers with.
