8	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
9	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
10	Section 20.700, to read as follows:
11	Sec. 20.700. Coordinated Intake for Homeless Programs. The purpose of this section is to
12	ensure accountability at all levels of the homeless service delivery system through the establishment of
13	a coordinated, centralized intake system. The Director of Health, the Executive Director of Human
14	Services and the Director of the Mayor's Office on Homelessness shall develop and implement a plan
15	for a coordinated, centralized intake system. This plan shall include, but not be limited to: a) a
16	centralized point of intake, at one site or at specified neighborhood sites; b) appraisal of client needs at
17	the initial intake for medical care, mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment, and eligibility
18	for benefit programs; c) client identification, and fingerimaging linked to the system currently used by
19	the Department of Human Services. A report on this plan and the implementation schedule shall be
20	presented to the Board of Supervisors within six months after the effective date of this ordinance.
