14 process of becoming eligible for a liver transplant at UCSF; and

15 WHEREAS, Lee Mallory recently completed San Francisco General Hospital’s non-
16 smoking class and has earned a certificate of achievement from the San Francisco
17 Department of Public Health Tobacco Free Project Stop Smoking Program; and

18 WHEREAS, Lee Mallory is contributing to the overall health of his community because
19 he has inspired numerous young singers to stop smoking in his wake; and

20 WHEREAS, Despite all odds, Lee Mallory celebrates his sixtieth birthday and seven
21 weeks as a non-smoker with a feature performance at Hotel Utah’s legendary “open mic” on
22 Monday, January 10, 2005 at 10pm; now, therefore be it

23 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims January
24 10, 2005, Lee Mallory Day in San Francisco.
