13 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. To promote Small Business Week and permit sidewalk sales of
15 merchandise, Public Works Code Section 724.1(b), setting a fee for temporary street space
16 occupancy, is hereby waived on Saturday, May 19, 2018, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 9
17 p.m., for the following areas:

18 3rd Street between Jerrold Avenue and Kirkwood Avenue;

19 3rd Street between Palou Avenue and Quesada Avenue;

20 9th Avenue between Lincoln Way and Kirkham Street;

21 14th Street between Church Street and Landers Street;

22 18th Street between Eureka Street and Douglas Street;

23 18th Street between Noe Street and Diamond Street;

24 24th Street between Diamond Street and Church Street;

25 Armstrong Avenue between 3rd Street and Keith Street;

Balboa Street between 33rd Avenue and 40th Avenue;


7 Section 2. All other provisions of Public Works Code Sections 724 et seq. shall remain
8 in full effect.
9

10 Section 3. Effective and Operative Dates; Retroactivity.

11 (a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs
12 when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not
13 sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the
14 Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

16 (b) If this ordinance becomes effective after May 19, 2018, this ordinance shall be
17 retroactive to that date.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Public Works Code - Waiver of Temporary Street Space Occupancy Permit Fee for Small Business Week Sidewalk Sales]

Ordinance waiving the fee required by Public Works Code, Section 724.1(b), for temporary street space occupancy permits on certain designated City streets on Saturday, May 19, 2018, to promote Small Business Week.

Existing Law

Section 724.1(b) of the Public Works Code requires that a fee of \$57.62 per day be charged “[f]or temporary street space occupancy for any purpose other than a building construction operation.”

Amendments to Current Law

This uncodified ordinance would temporarily waive the fee required by Section 724.1(b) of the Public Works Code, in certain parts of the City, in connection with Small Business Week. The fee would be waived between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m. on Saturday, May 19, 2018. If the ordinance becomes effective after May 19, 2018, the ordinance is retroactive to that date.
