3	Resolution proclaiming October 20, 2004 as A-day in San Francisco.

5	WHEREAS, the America Legion War Memorial Commission will celebrate the 60 th
6	Anniversary of General Douglas MacArthur's historic landing in Leyte, Philippines in October
7	of 2004;
8	WHEREAS, by the summer of 1944, American forces had fought their way across the
9	Pacific, to face the most formidable post of the Japanese Empire: the Philippines; and
10	WHEREAS, the Japanese strength in the Philippines totaled about 432,000 troops,
11	with General Makino's 16 th Division controlling more than 20,000 soldiers on Leyte; and
12	WHEREAS, the Japanese forces had between 100 and 120 occupational airfields in
13	the Philippines, with 884 aircraft of all types; and
14	WHEREAS, to take Leyte, American and Allied forces mounted the largest amphibious
15	operation to date in the Pacific; and
16	WHEREAS, The Joint Chiefs of Staff designated General MacArthur supreme
17	commander of sea, air, and land forces drawn from both the Southwest Pacific and Central
18	Pacific theaters of operation; and
19	WHEREAS, Allied naval forces consisted primarily of the U.S. Seventh Fleet and the
20	new Sixth Army Service Command; and
21	WHEREAS, the landing was designated A-day, Attack Day, to avoid confusion with D-
22	day and the Allied liberation of Europe; and
23	WHEREAS, the Army and Navy were given one month to implement General
24	MacArthur's plans, and did so successfully on October 20, 1944; and

1	WHEREAS, in the days that followed, the Sixth Army made steady progress inland and
2	secured the provincial capital of Tacloban; and
3	WHEREAS, two days later, General MacArthur presided over a ceremony to restore
4	civil government to Leyte; and
5	WHEREAS, the commemorative celebration will honor the living relatives of President
6	Sergio Osmena and Generals Douglas MacArthur and Carlos Romulo; and now, therefore be
7	
8	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
9	designates October 20, 2004 as the official 60 th Anniversary of A-day.
