10	WHEREAS, The initial plan design included 75 movable chairs on the plaza for use by
11	the public; and
12	WHEREAS, Funding for the chairs was trimmed from the budget due to unexpected
13	project costs; and
14	WHEREAS, The new design has been more inviting and the Square used by more
15	people than ever before, consistently filling benches and ledges to capacity on nice days; and
16	WHEREAS, A six-month study last year proved that movable chairs are used and
17	appreciated by the public; and
18	WHEREAS, Members of the Union Square Association contributed money to purchase
19	75 movable chairs, 12 tables and 4 umbrellas to meet the public's expectations; and
20	WHEREAS, The Union Square Association on behalf of its members, proudly offers
	this gift of furniture to the city of San Francisco and its residents to enjoy in Union Square from
