Resolution declaring October 30, 2012, as Linda Avery-Herbert Day in the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, The mission of the Planning Department is to guide the orderly and prudent use of land, in both natural and built environments, with the purpose of improving the quality of life and embracing the diverse perspectives of those who live in, work in and visit San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission is tasked with establishing the lofty vision of the City's General Plan and implementing that vision through review of specific developments; and

WHEREAS, Since 1981, Ms. Avery-Herbert was employed with the Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Avery-Herbert embarked upon a fortuitous career starting off as a Supervising Clerk and along the way was promoted to Senior Clerk Typist, Principal Clerk, Executive Secretary II, Executive Secretary III, Administrative Secretary – City Planning Commission, Chief of Administration, Special Assistant XVI, and finally Manager IV as Commission Secretary; and

WHEREAS, In that role Ms. Avery-Herbert was the gatekeeper for the rules of order, ensuring an orderly hearing every Thursday; and

WHEREAS, Surely this workload would have exhausted a mere mortal; and WHEREAS, In 2008, the voters saw fit to double that workload with the creation of the Historic Preservation Commission; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Avery-Herbert attended to the needs of this Commission with the same high level of professionalism and integrity; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Avery-Herbert ensured that the hearings are orderly; and WHEREAS, Ms. Avery-Herbert watched the content of each calendar ensuring the "i"s were dotted and the "t"s were crossed; and
