

1 [Report of Assessment Costs for Sidewalk Inspection and Repair Program]

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3 **Resolution approving report of assessment costs submitted by the Director of Public**
4 **Works for sidewalk and curb repairs through the Sidewalk Inspection and Repair**
5 **Program ordered to be performed by said Director pursuant to Public Works Code,**
6 **Sections 706.9 and Administrative Code, Section 80, the costs thereof having been paid**
7 **for out of a revolving fund.**

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9 RESOLVED, That after public hearings on December 29, 2014, January 21, 2015,
10 February 11, 2015, February 25, 2015, March 18, 2015, April 14, 2015, May 13, 2015, May
11 27, 2015, April, 14, 2015, May 13, 2015, May 27, 2015, July 1, 2015, July 22, 2015,
12 August 5, 2015, August 26, 2015, September 9, 2015, October 7, 2015, October 28, 2015,
13 November 18, 2015, and December 2, 2015, regarding any objections to the Director of
14 Public Works for work done or caused to be done through the Sidewalk Inspection and Repair
15 Program pursuant to the provisions of Public Works Code, Section 706.9 and Administrative
16 Code, Section 80, the costs thereof having been paid for by the City and County out of a
17 revolving fund, and after making such modifications, if any, as the Board of Supervisors
18 deems necessary, the Board does hereby confirm said Report of Assessment Cost described
19 in Public Works Order No.184806; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution and a copy of said itemized
21 Report of Assessment Costs confirmed by the Board shall be transmitted to the Controller and
22 Tax Collector of the City and County, whereupon it shall be the duty of said officers to add the
23 amount of each assessment to the next regular bill for taxes levied against each respective
24 parcel of land, and thereafter each said amount shall be collected at the same time and in the
25 same manner as ordinary City and County taxes are collected, and shall be subject to the

1 same procedure under foreclosure and sale in case of delinquency as provided for ordinary
2 taxes of the City and County; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That all monies received in payment of the assessments shall
4 be credited to the revolving fund provided for in Public Works Code, Section 706.8, except
5 that the portion of the assessments attributable to the cost of City Administration shall be
6 credited to the Administrative Account of Sidewalk Repair.
