17	subcontract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
18	Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as		
19	if set forth fully herein; and,		
20	WHEREAS, The contract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$1,806; now,		
21	therefore, be it		
22	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract		
23	agreement in the amount of \$69,151 with UCSF, the primary contractor for services under the		
24	"Child Care Health Linkages Project"; and, be it

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
2	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions		
4	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when		
5	the agreement expires.
