3 **Resolution approving the settlement of the unlitigated claim filed by 100-120 Powell**
4 **Owner L.P., L.L.C. against the City and County of San Francisco for \$5,362,325; the**
5 **claim was filed on January 14, 2022; the claim involves allegations of property damage**
6 **to the Hotel Union Square caused by shelter-in-place (SIP) hotel guests during the**
7 **COVID-19 pandemic and resulting loss of use; other material terms of the settlement**
8 **include a mutual full and final release, with each party to bear their own costs.**

10 WHEREAS, 100-120 Powell Owner L.P., L.L.C., a Delaware limited liability company,
11 filed a claim on January 14, 2022, against the City and County of San Francisco; and

12 WHEREAS, The claim involves allegations of property damage to the Hotel Union
13 Square caused by shelter-in-place (SIP) hotel guests during the COVID-19 pandemic and
14 resulting loss of use; and

15 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Human Service Agency has recommended settlement
16 of the claim by payment of \$5,362,325 and other material terms of the settlement include a
17 mutual full and final release, with each party to bear their own costs; now, therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, That pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.22, the Board of
19 Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle and compromise the claim by
20 payment of \$5,362,325 and other material terms of the settlement include a mutual full and
21 final release, with each party to bear their own costs.
