[Carl Rakosi Commendation]

Resolution commending the poet Carl Rakosi on the occasion of his 98th birthday.

WHEREAS, The poet Carl Rakosi was born on November 6, 1903 of Hungarian parents in Berlin, Germany and came to the United States with his father and stepmother in 1910, and;

WHEREAS, Carl Rakosi received his B.A. in 1924 and M.A. in 1926 from the University of Wisconsin, and completed his Masters of Social Work at the University of Pennsylvania in 1940, and;

WHEREAS, Carl Rakosi practiced social work and psychotherapy, and was Director of the Jewish Family and Children's Service in Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Callman Rawley, his legally adopted professional name for many years, and;

WHEREAS, In the 1930s, Carl Rakosi was a member of a group of poets called "The Objectivists," a modernist movement whose interests were rooted less in romanticism and more in the practical uses of poetry with a focus on common words and objects, some of its members being Louis Zukofsky, Charles Reznikoff, Lorine Niedecker, Basil Bunting, Kenneth Rexroth, and George Oppen, and;

WHEREAS, Carl Rakosi contributed to the "Objectivists" issue of Poetry magazine in February of 1931, and his work was later included in "An Objectivists Anthology" published in France in 1932 by To publishers, and;

WHEREAS, Carl Rakosi has published many works including, "Selected Poems" (1941), "Amulet" (1967), "Ere-Voice" (1971), "Ex Cranium, Night" (1975), "My Experience in Parnassus" (1977), "The Earth Suite" (1977), "Droles de Journal" (1981), "Spiritus I" (1983), "Collected Prose" (1983), "Collected Poems" (1986), and "Poems 1923-1941" (1995) and;

WHEREAS, Carl Rakosi has been living and writing poetry in San Francisco for over 25 years, where he has been a great influence and inspiration for several generations of younger poets; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the board of Supervisors of San Francisco commends Carl Rakosi for his poetry and offers best wishes on the occasion of his 98th birthday, November 6th, 2001.
