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8 WHEREAS, On December 18, 2018, the Board of Supervisors ordered submitted to  
9 the voters for the November 5, 2019, election a Charter Amendment to establish the Free City  
10 College Fund to defray certain costs of City College students, and to require annual  
11 appropriations in designated amounts to the Fund, on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
12 Supervisors in File No. 181001, submitted pursuant to Section 300(a) of the Municipal  
13 Elections Code; and

14 WHEREAS, Section 370(a) of the Municipal Elections Code provides that any measure  
15 submitted to the voters under Section 300(a) of the Municipal Elections Code may be  
16 withdrawn by the Board of Supervisors at any time up to the legal deadline for submission of  
17 such measures; and

18 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors wishes to withdraw the order of submission of  
19 said Charter Amendment for the November 5, 2019, election; now, therefore, be it

20 MOVED, That pursuant to Section 370(a) of the Municipal Elections Code, the Board of  
21 Supervisors hereby withdraws the measure previously submitted to the voters, for the election  
22 to be held on November 5, 2019, to establish the Free City College Fund to defray certain  
23 costs of City College students and to require annual appropriations in designated amounts to  
24 the Fund, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 181001.  
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
