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3 **Resolution concurring with the Controller’s certification that security services can be**
4 **practically performed by private contractor for lower cost than similar services**
5 **performed by City and County employees.**

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7 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
8 Proposition “J” in November, 1976 adding Section 300-1 to the Charter that was replaced by
9 Charter Section 10.104.15 allowing City departments to contract with private companies for
10 specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and
11 County employees; and

12 WHEREAS, The Office of Contract Administration has sought and received a formal
13 bid from a San Francisco security firm and wishes to contract for security services; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Controller certified on July 30,2001 that said services can be
15 performed at lower cost to the City and County by a contractor than by employees of the City
16 and County; now, therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller’s
18 certification and approves that the Office of Contract Administration may contract for security
19 services for FY 2001-2002.
