Resolution approving the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$272,846 to construct a new sewer on Tennessee Street from Cesar Chavez Street to midway toward 26<sup>th</sup> Street and on Cesar Chavez Street from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to Tennessee Street.

WHEREAS, The General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) declared an emergency to construct a new sewer on Tennessee Street from Cesar Chavez Street to midway toward 26<sup>th</sup> Street and on Cesar Chavez Street from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to Tennessee Street, by a letter dated March 22, 2001; and

WHEREAS, The existing public sewer crossing Block 4315 (bordered by Tennessee Street, Cesar Chavez Street, 26<sup>th</sup> Street, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street) was in imminent danger of being crushed by the on-going construction of a pile-supported building; and

WHEREAS, The existing sewer did not have a legal easement; therefore, the City's liability could have been significant if the sewer undermined the new construction; and

WHEREAS, The Declaration of Emergency was ratified for Clean Water Program Contract No. CW-305E, Tennessee/Cesar Chavez Streets Emergency Sewer Construction, by SFPUC Resolution No. 01-0117, dated May 22, 2001; and

WHEREAS, The construction for this contract was completed on May 10, 2001 by the contractor, Harty Pipeline, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, The original contract amount was \$189,000, and the original duration was 28 consecutive calendar days; and

WHEREAS, The actual contract amount increased by \$83,846 for a final contract amount of \$272,846, and the contract duration was extended 6 consecutive calendar days for a total of 34 consecutive calendar days, to accommodate the removal and disposal of hazardous

materials encountered during construction, mitigations for heavy groundwater and non-reusable existing sub-base soils, and adjustments to the actual bid item quantities used during construction; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 6, Article IV, Section 6.60 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco requires the Board of Supervisors' approval for all emergency contracts that exceed \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, Funds for this contract are available from the Repair and Replacement Fund under Job Order No. 0197J (Fund 5C/CPF/R&R, FAMIS Project No. CENRNRH14040); and

WHEREAS, HRC subcontracting goals are not required for an emergency contract; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$272,846 for Clean Water Program Contract No. CW-305E, Tennessee/Cesar Chavez Streets Emergency Sewer Construction.
