6 program in 1964 to provide an opportunity for gifted and highly motivated Americans to gain  
7 first-hand experience in governing the nation; and,

8 WHEREAS, White House Fellows spend a year as assistants to senior White House  
9 staff, the Vice President, Cabinet officers, and other top-ranking officials; and,

10 WHEREAS, White House Fellows have a record of remarkable achievement early in  
11 their careers, the skills required to serve at the highest levels of government, the potential to  
12 be leaders in their profession, and a proven commitment to public service; and,

13 WHEREAS, Each year the President's Commission on White House Fellowships offers  
14 up to 19 Fellowships to outstanding Americans; and,

15 WHEREAS, San Franciscan Daniel F. Feldman is an attorney in the International  
16 Finance Group at Morrison & Foerster, specializing in financing infrastructure projects in  
17 developing nations; and,

18 WHEREAS, Daniel F. Feldman also works on pro bono international human rights  
19 issues, including advocacy work for the Lawyers Committee for Human Rights; and,

20 WHEREAS, Daniel F. Feldman helped to found Legal Services for Entrepreneurs,  
21 which provides pro bono legal counsel to low-income individuals who are starting or  
22 expanding businesses in distressed neighborhoods; and,

23 WHEREAS, Daniel F. Feldman has been selected as a White House Fellow for the  
24 1999-2000 program; now, therefore, be it
