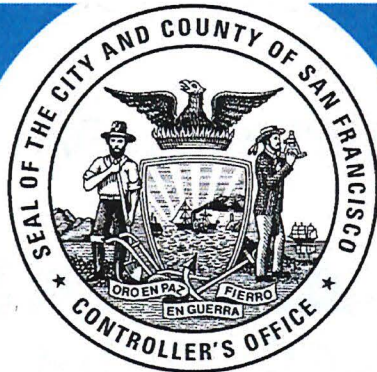

The Controller's Office manages the Performance Program which provides on-going performance reporting for departments, policymakers, and the public.

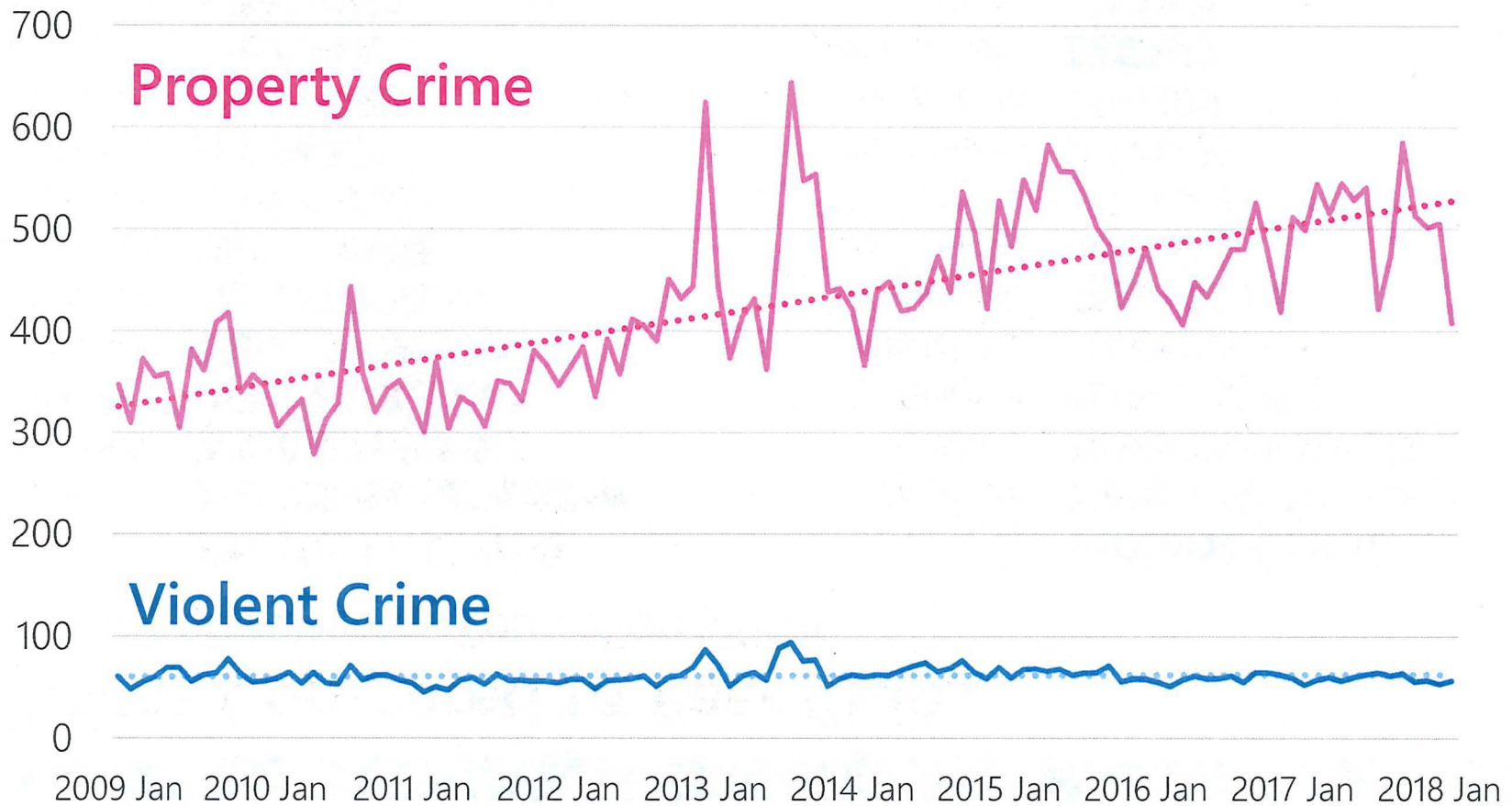
- **Performance Scorecards** – [sfgov.org/scorecards](http://sfgov.org/scorecards) – provide regular updates on key citywide performance measures

Per 100,000 San Francisco Residents

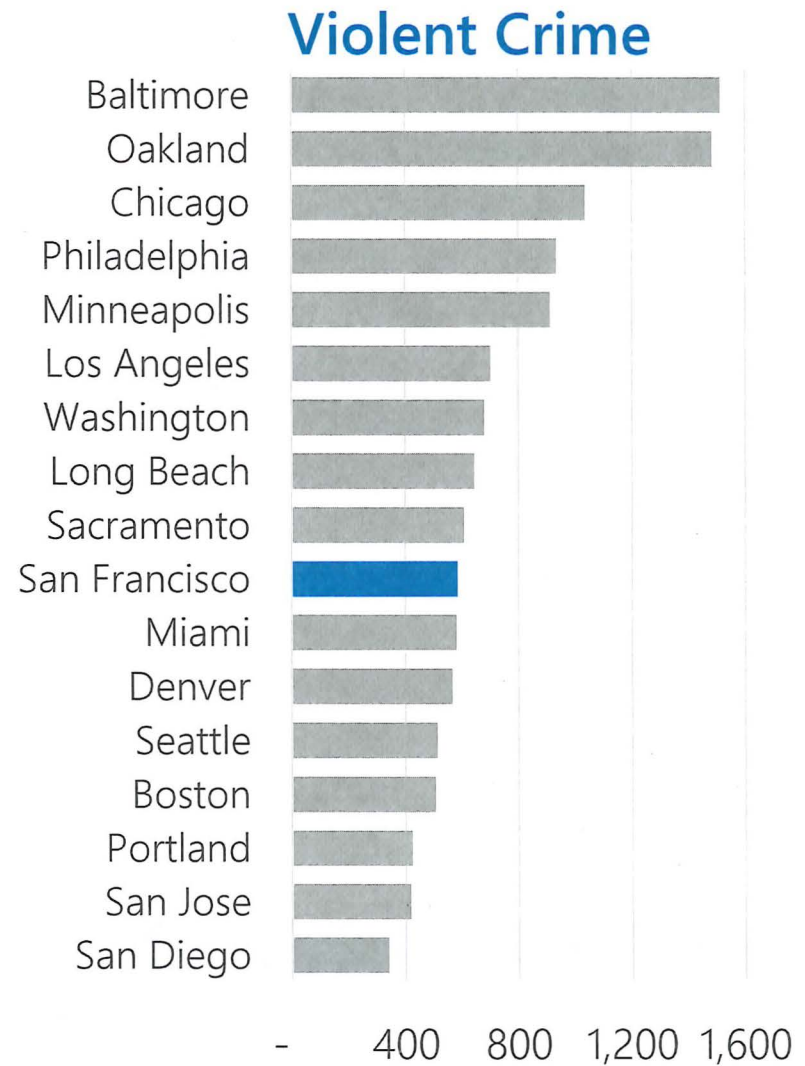
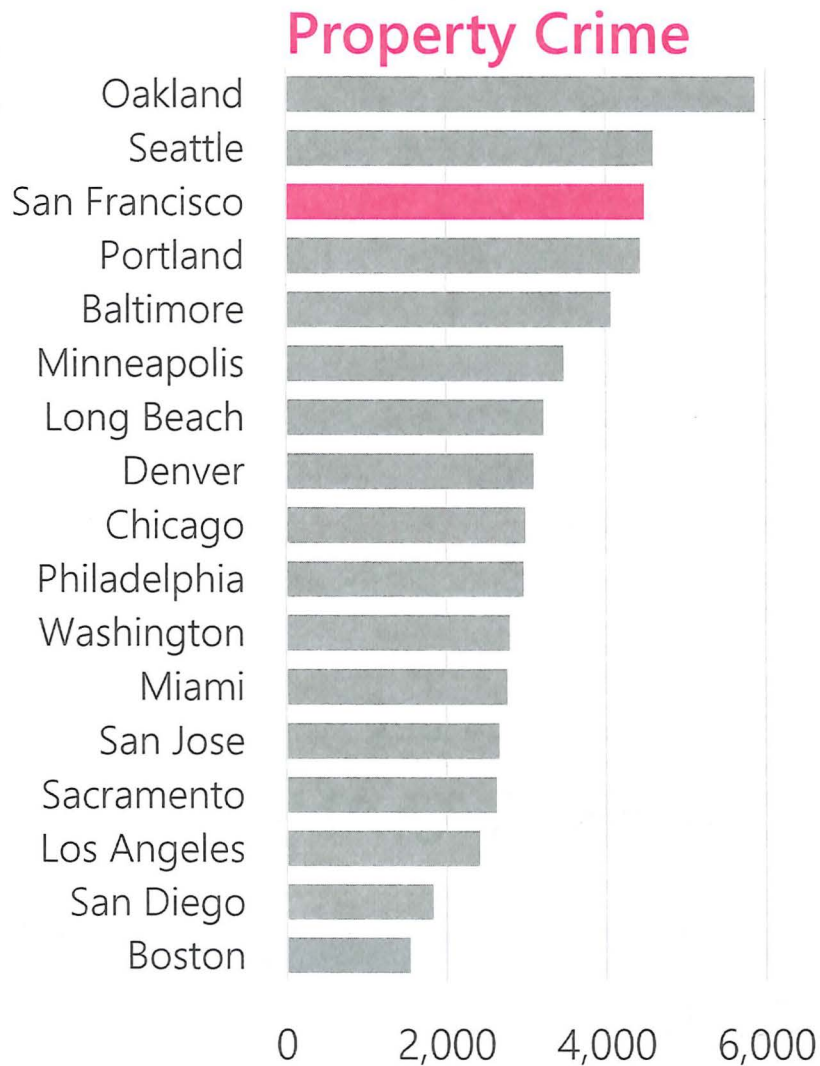

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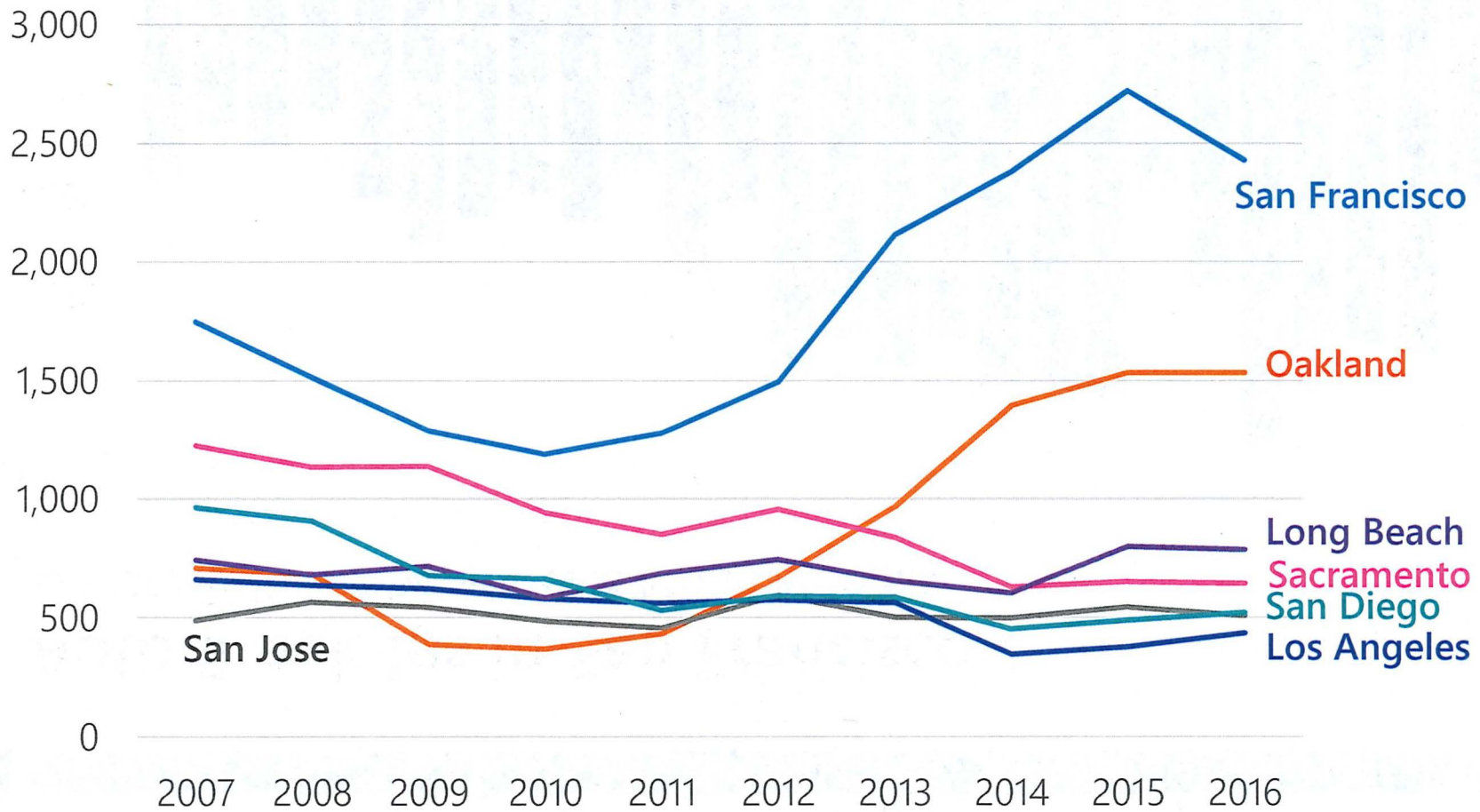
## Crime Compared to Peer Cities

Per 100,000 Daytime Population (2016)



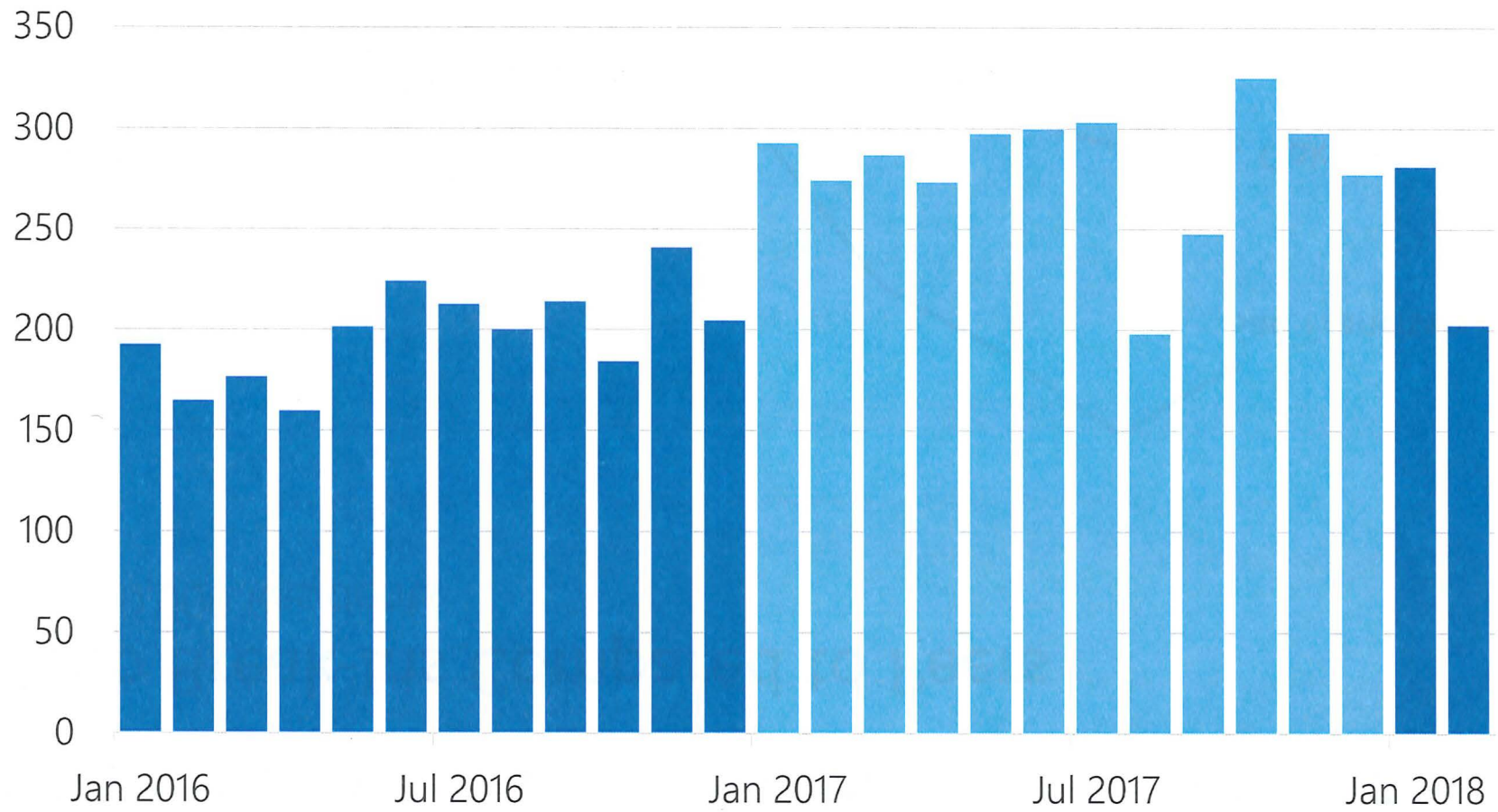
## Auto Break-Ins Compared to Peers

## Auto Break-Ins in San Francisco

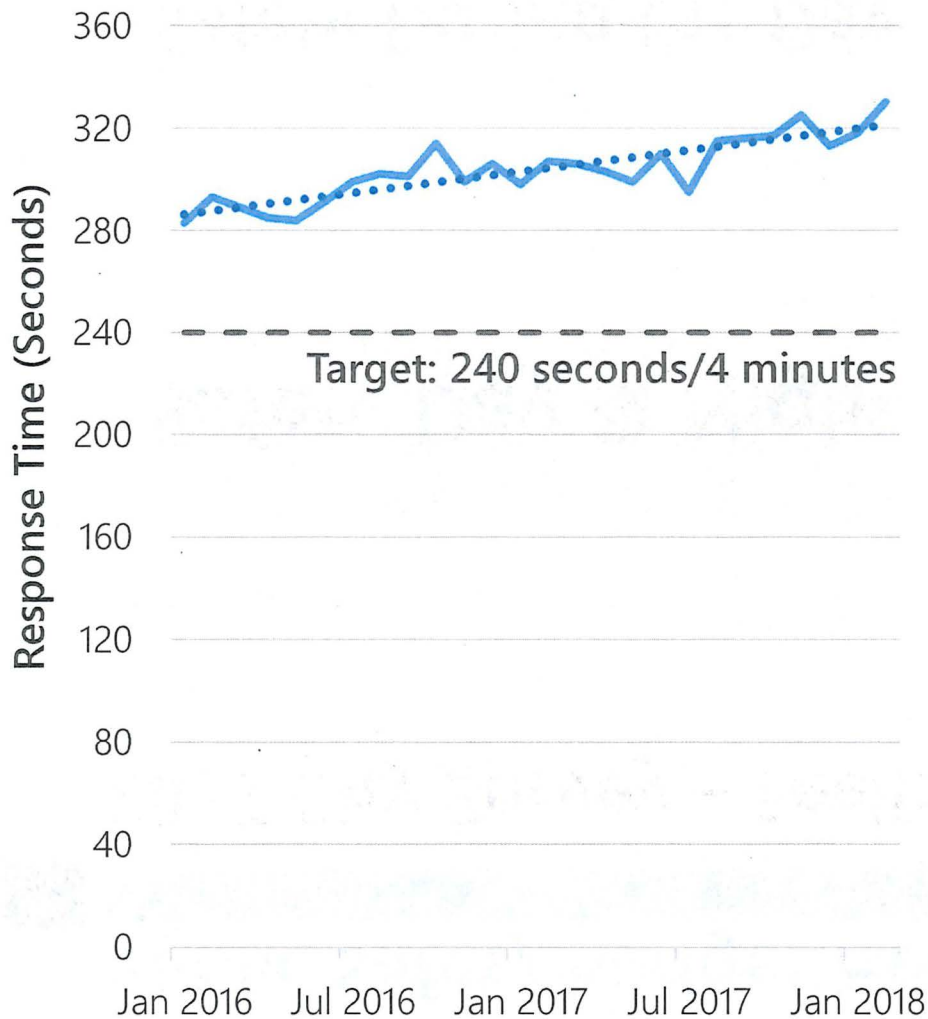
January 2016 – February 2018 Monthly Totals

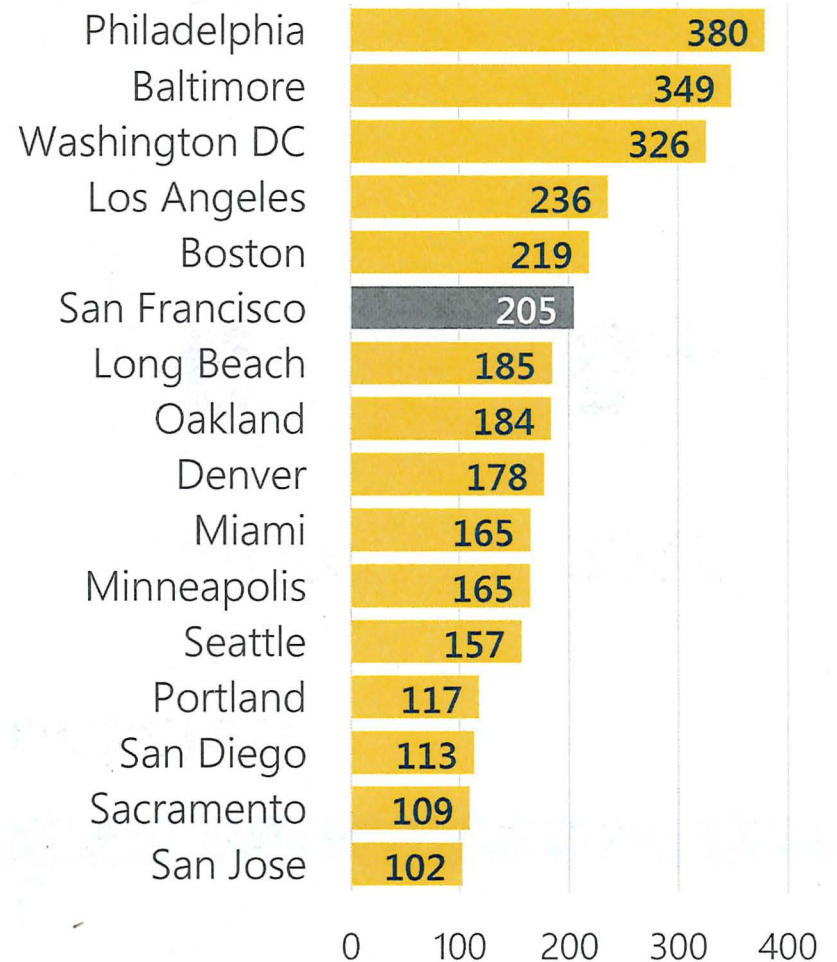

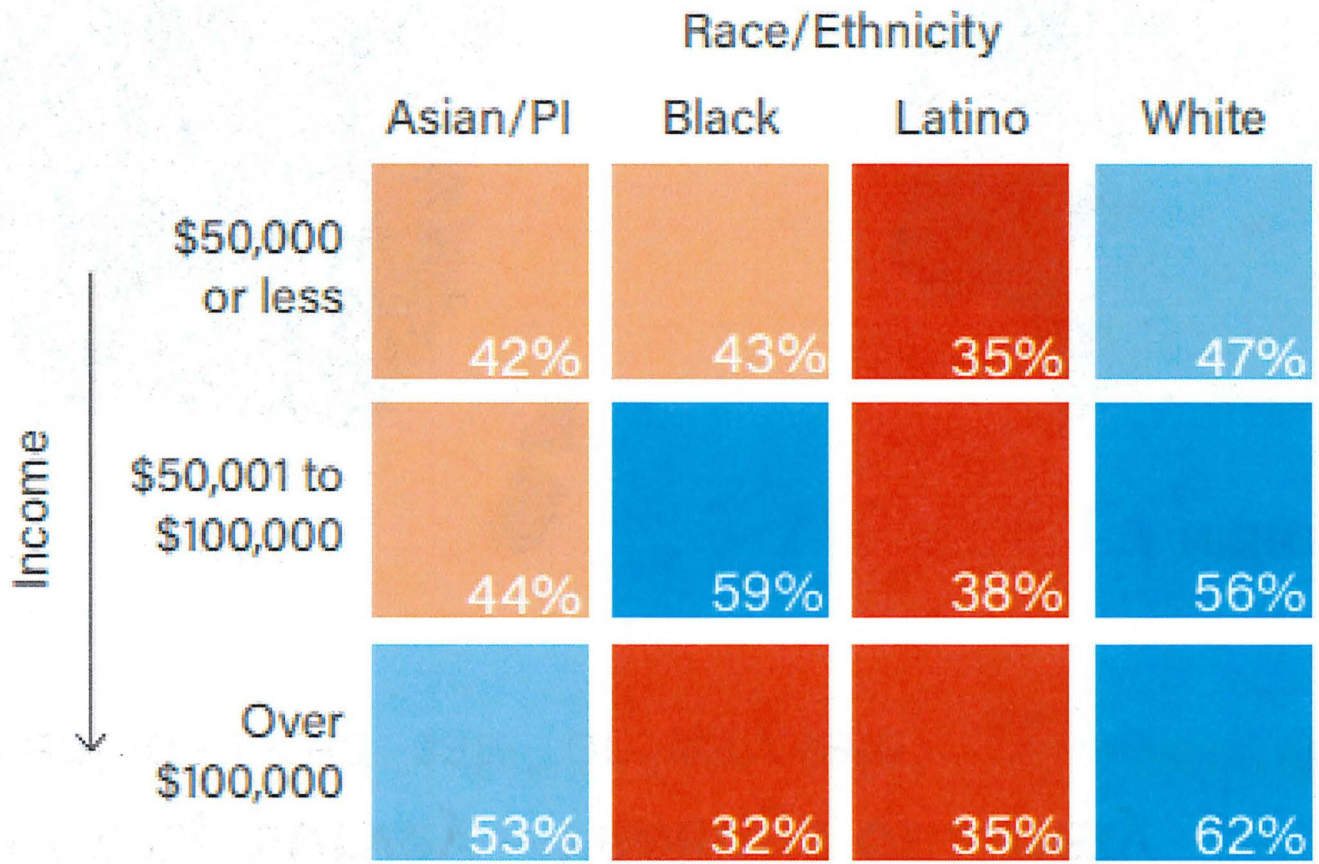

% Who Feel Safe Day and Night

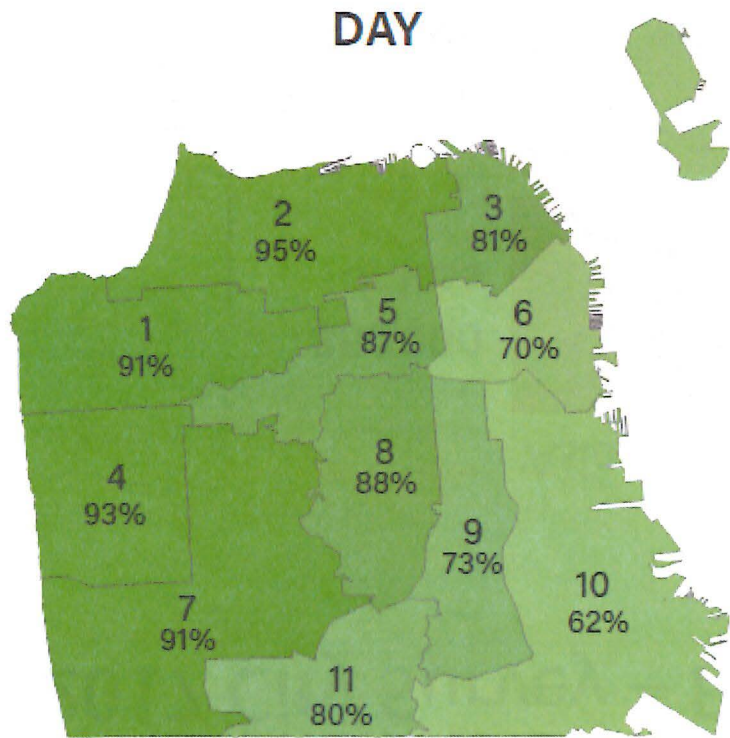

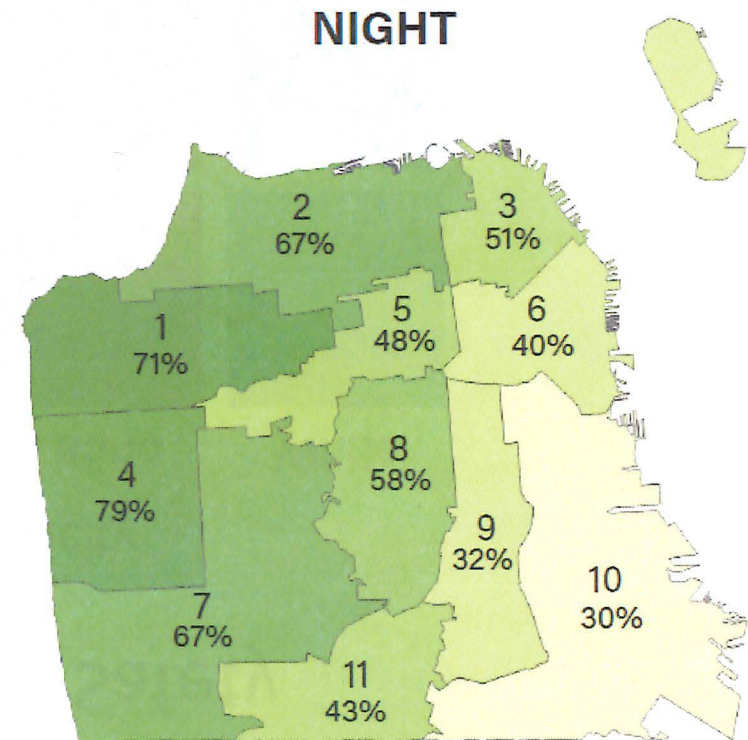

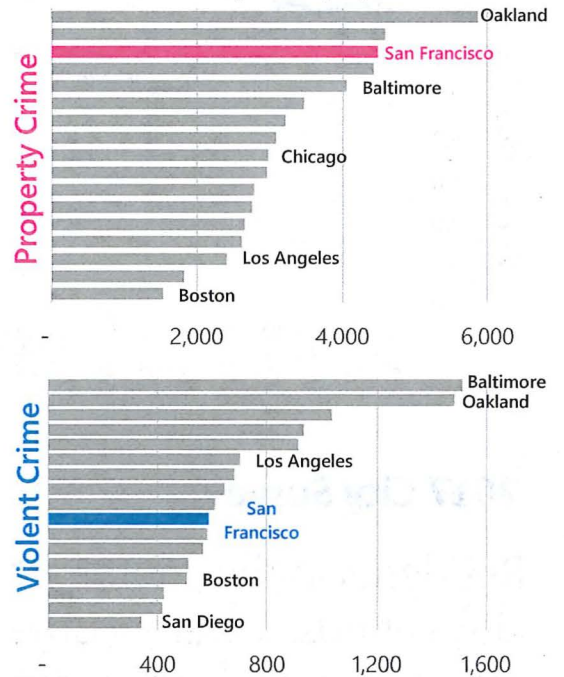

Per 100,000 residents

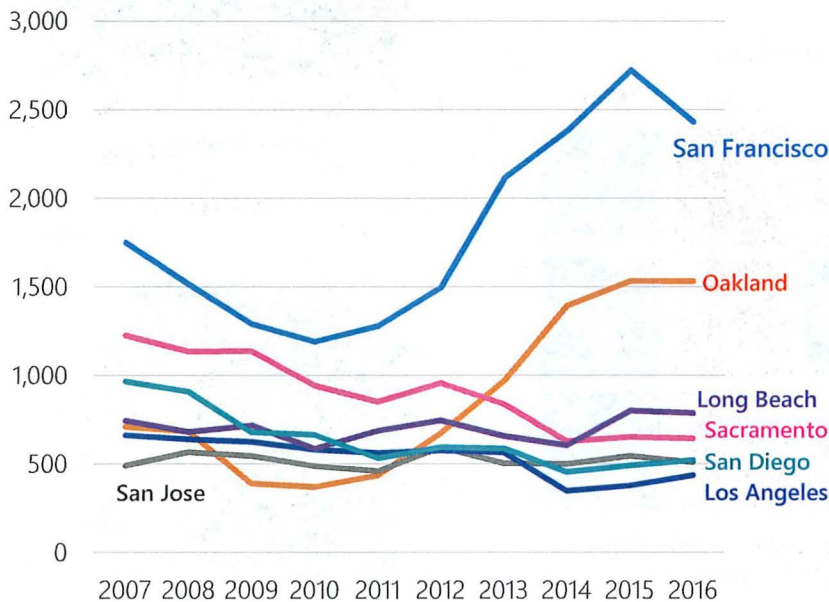


Comparison with Peers (2016)  
Per 100,000 daytime population

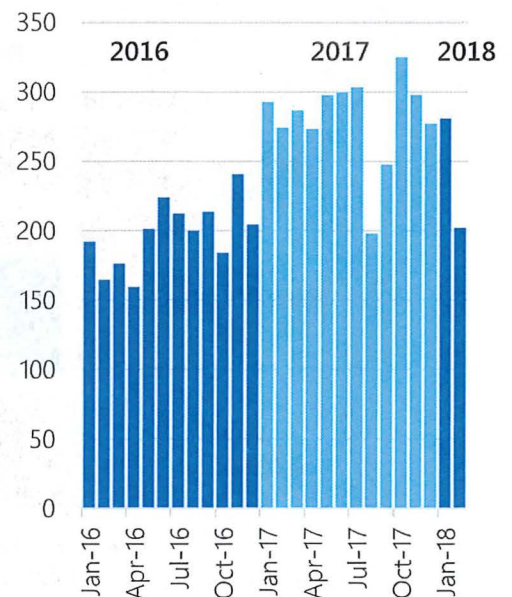


## Auto Break-Ins

Per 100,000 residents

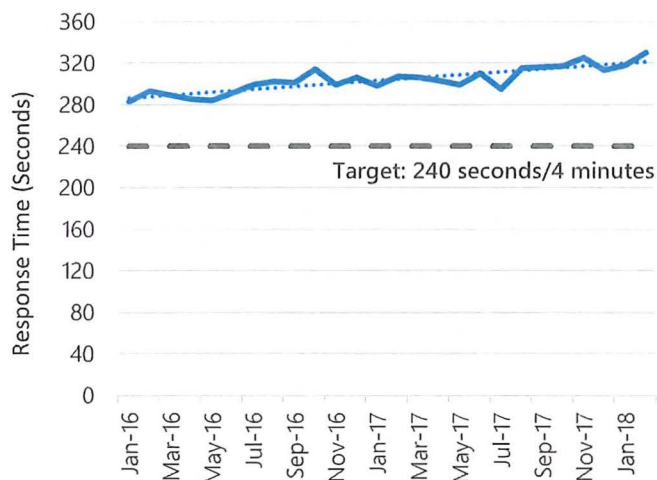

Target: Respond within 4 minutes (240 seconds)



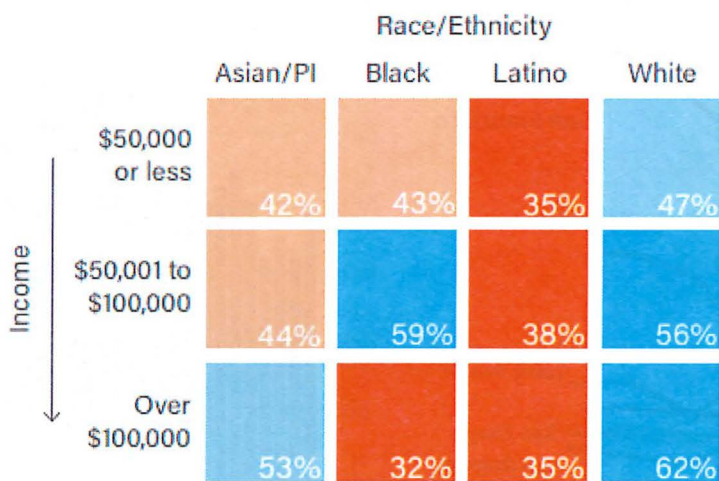
### Police Staffing Benchmarking

Per 100,000 daytime population

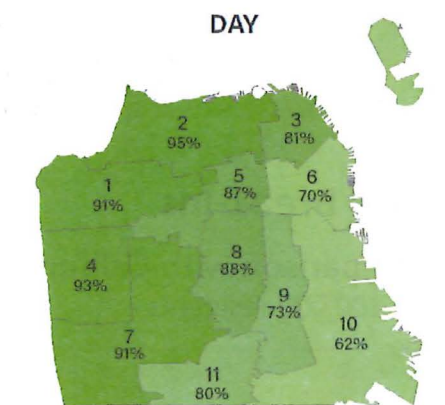


### 2017 City Survey

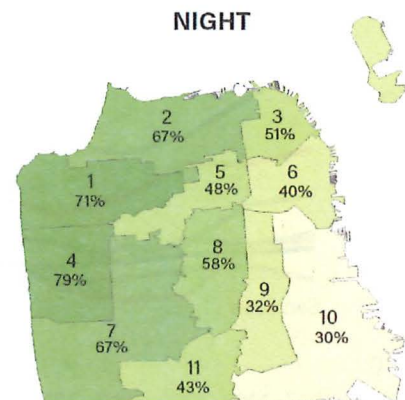
Residents in the southeast part of the city, Latinos, lower income, and women report feeling less safe during the day and night compared to most San Franciscans.
