4	(DPH) to enter into an agreement with the California Department of State Hospitals, to
5	provide funding for the Felony Incompetent to Stand Trial (IST) Mental Health Diversion
6	Program for individuals found incompetent to stand trial for a term of five years from
7	July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2030, having anticipated revenue of \$15,060,000; and
8	authorizing DPH to enter into amendments or modifications to the agreement that do
9	not materially increase the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to
10	effectuate the purposes of the agreement or this Resolution.
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12	WHEREAS, The California Department of State Hospitals (DSH) administers the
13	Felony Incompetent to Stand Trial (IST) Mental Health Diversion Program to fund mental
14	health diversion services; and
15	WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health (DPH) and DSH wish to enter into an
16	agreement to support San Francisco's pre-trial Felony IST Mental Health Diversion Program
17	to provide behavioral health treatment and wraparound services to meet the individual needs
18	of Felony IST Mental Health Diversion clients; and
19	WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(a), requires Board of Supervisors' approval by
20	Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, anticipates revenue of \$1,000,000 or
21	more; and
22	WHEREAS, The proposed agreement contained in File No. 250776, is substantially in
23	final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by
24	the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

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1	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the agreement in
2	substantially the form contained in File No. 250776; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes DPH to make any
4	modifications to the agreement, prior to its final execution by all parties, that DPH determines,
5	in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of
6	the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or
7	advisable to effectuate the purposes of the agreement, and are in compliance with all
8	applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the agreement being fully executed by
10	all parties, DPH shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed
11	copy for inclusion in File No. 250776; this requirement and obligation resides with the
12	Department and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the
13	validity of approved agreement.
