8 Francisco with her family at the age of 22, and has called San Francisco home for the past 78
9 years; and

10 WHEREAS, Corinne met her husband, Solomon, and raised their family of four children
11 in North Beach, working tirelessly to support the family as blue-collar workers in the restaurant
12 and factory industries and owner-operators of a laundromat; and

13 WHEREAS, Despite the odds stacked against her from the beginning, she established
14 a long and successful life as an entrepreneur, blue-collar worker, and mother; and

15 WHEREAS, Corinne co-owned and operated Chinese Kitchen in Mill Valley, while
16 raising her children and building a future for her family; and

17 WHEREAS, In 1963, Corinne and Solomon decided to set their roots in San Francisco
18 and used their savings to purchase their first home in the Richmond District, where they
19 remained to this day; and

20 WHEREAS, After her husband's passing in 1967, Corinne demonstrated extraordinary
21 strength, determination, and resilience, and forged fiercely forward with four young children as
22 a single mother; and

23 WHEREAS, In her retirement, Corinne fills her days with hobbies, playing mahjong,
24 staying connected to current events through reading Chinese newspapers, and showcasing

1 her culinary prowess through a wide array of dishes from her signature Chinese recipes to
2 spaghetti and ever-most popular prime rib roasts; and

11 grandchildren; now, therefore, be it


12 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
