3	Ordinance amending the Police Code to extend the end date of the Cannabis Event
4	Pilot Program from December 31, 2023, to December 31, 2026.

10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. Article 16 of the Police Code is hereby amended by revising Section
12	1621.5, to read as follows:
13	SEC. 1621.5. EVENTS.
14	* * * *
15	(k) Pilot Program. Prior to January 1, 2020 2027, the Director may issue Cannabis Event
16	Permits only in connection with events that meet all the following criteria:
17	(1) The event has previously been held on a regular basis;
18	(2) The event, in prior years, has received a City-issued permit; and
19	(3) At the event, in prior years, there has been significant unregulated cannabis sales or
20	consumption, which the Director determines could be reduced or eliminated at the event by
21	the issuance of a Cannabis Events Permit. Except as stated in the following paragraph, Tthe
22	restrictions imposed by this subsection (k) on the operation of this Section 1621.5 shall
23	become inoperative on January 1, 2020 2027. On or after that date, the City Attorney is authorized
24	to cause this subsection (k) of Section 1621.5 to be removed from the Police Code.

1	The Director may extend the pilot program set forth in this subsection (k) one or more times, up to
2	December 31, 2023, such that no Cannabis Event Permit may issue except as provided under this
3	subsection (k) prior to the date the Director's extension of the pilot program, if any, ends. The Director
4	may extend the pilot program as provided herein onexly upon the Director's written determination that,
5	in light of other duties imposed on the Office of Cannabis, the Office lacks sufficient resources to
6	process additional Cannabis Event Permit applications or to otherwise effectively regulate cannabis-
7	related events.
8	* * * *
9	Section 2. Effective Date; Retroactivity.
10	(a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs
11	when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not
12	sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the
13	Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
14	(b) Upon the effective date of this ordinance, the ordinance shall be retroactive to
15	January 1, 2024.
16	
17	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
18	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
19	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
20	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
21	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
22	the official title of the ordinance.

## Temporary Events: Pilot Program

- Pilot Program requires:
  - The event had previously been held on a regular basis
  - The event, in prior years, had received a City-issued permit
  - The event had significant unregulated cannabis sales or consumption
- Currently set to expire December 31, 2023



## Requirements from the State

- These events still need to abide by State regulations
  - 2 State licenses
    - (*§*15600 15601)
  - Age restrictions
    - (§15602(a))
  - Obscuring public visibility
    - (§15603(b))
  - Security requirements
    - (§15601(h))

- Transportation requirements
  - (§15602(g))
- Designated retail area
  - (§15602(b))
- Limited access areas
  - (§15601(n))
- Designated on site storage
  - (§15602(h))

## Practical Effects of State Regulations

- Cost prohibitive for event organizers (especially small and midsized events)
  - Fencing, mesh coverage to obscure public visibility, security personnel
- Time intensive process
  - Identifying a viable location is very challenging
- Overall, State regulations favor large, outdoor events
  - These events have both the space and funding required



## OEWD Working with OOC to Identify Potential Sites

- Cannabis events as a potential economic recovery tool
  - Benefits for local cannabis businesses, cannabis tourism, and arts/culture/entertainment sector
- Working with OOC to identify potential locations that could meet state and local requirements
- Exploring approaches to stakeholder engagement to source locations/event types that are of interest to industry leaders
