3 **Ordinance adding Section 10.100-354 to Article XIII of the San Francisco Administrative**
4 **Code to create the Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Fund, and increasing**
5 **parking fines by \$2.50.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
11 Section 10.100-354, to read as follows:

12 Sec. 10.100-354. **CRIMINAL JUSTICE FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION FUND.**

13 (a) Establishment of Fund. The Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Fund is hereby
14 established as a category four fund for the purpose of receiving all funds collected pursuant to
15 California Government Code Sections 76100 and 76101 from penalty assessments in parking
16 cases.

17 (b) Use of the Fund. The monies in this fund are payable only for the purpose of
18 assisting the City and County of San Francisco (the "City") in the expansion, renovation, or
19 construction of criminal court facilities at 850 Bryant St., San Francisco, or construction of a
20 court facility to replace or supplement the criminal court facility at 850 Bryant St.

21 (c) Administration of Fund. All funds shall be expended as jointly determined by the
22 Criminal Justice Facilities Fund Committee (consisting of the Presiding Judge and Chief
23 Executive Officer of the Superior Court of the County of San Francisco, the District Attorney,
24 the President of the Board of Supervisors and the Public Defender), with the approval of the

1 Board of Supervisors. The fund shall be maintained in the Controller's office, which shall
2 record all receipts and expenditures.

3 Section 2. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 76100, the fine for parking
4 violations shall increase by two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50). The clerk is directed to provide
5 a copy of this ordinance to the San Francisco Superior Court in order to increase bail
6 accordingly. One dollar (\$1.00) of each two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) collected shall be
7 deposited in the State Court House Construction Fund, and one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50)
8 in the Criminal Justice Facilities Fund, as is required by state law.

9 Section 3. The Board of Supervisors finds that the creation of this fund is necessary to
10 fund the construction and/or renovation of criminal court facilities.
