

1 [Authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to amend its contract with  
2 Micromenders/GC Micro to increase the contract amount to \$~~25~~ 18 million.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to enter into the Sixth**  
4 **amendment between the City and Micromenders/GC Micro (part of the Computer Store**  
5 **procurement vehicle), in which the amendment shall increase the contract’s amount to \$~~25~~**  
6 **18 million.**

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8 WHEREAS, the Committee on Information Technology and the Office of Contract  
9 Administration, by competitive bidding, developed the Computer Store procurement method for  
10 the purchase of products and services related to Information Technology; and

11 WHEREAS, the original contract with Micromenders/GC Micro was dated  
12 January 1, 2004, had a contract amount of \$9,999,999, with possible extensions through  
13 December 31, 2008, and had a term of three years, through December 31, 2006; and

14 WHEREAS, the contract has been amended five times, and one amendment raised the  
15 contract amount as indicated:

- 16 First amendment, July 1, 2004;
- 17 Second amendment, February 11, 2005;
- 18 Third amendment, December 29, 2006,
- 19 Fourth amendment, August 2, 2007, raised to \$13 million
- 20 Fifth amendment, December 28, 2007.

21 WHEREAS, the Office of Contract Administration estimates that the money projected to be  
22 spent with Micromenders/GC Micro could reach the contract amount in the reasonably near future;  
23 and

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1           WHEREAS, Charter section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations," subsection (b),  
2 requires Board of Supervisors approval of any contract estimated to exceed \$10 million in  
3 expenditures; now, therefore, be it

4           RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Office of Contract  
5 Administration enter into the Sixth amendment to the contract with Micromenders/GC Micro; and  
6 be it

7           FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Amendment shall increase the contract amount for the  
8 contract with Micromenders/GC Micro from \$13 million to ~~\$25~~ 18 million.

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
