

1 [Proposition J Contract/Certification of Specified Contracted-Out Services for Department of  
2 Juvenile Probation]

3 **Resolution concurring with the Controller's certification that services can be performed**  
4 **by private contractor for a lower cost than similar work performed by City and County**  
5 **employees for food service in Juvenile Hall for the Department of Juvenile Probation.**

7 WHEREAS, The Electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed  
8 Proposition J in November 1976, allowing City and County Departments to contract with  
9 private companies for specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar  
10 work by City and County employees (Charter Section 10.104.15); and,

11 WHEREAS, The Controller has determined that the award of a contract for the services  
12 listed below to a private contractor will achieve substantial cost savings for the City; and,

13 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco must reconcile a projected \$483  
14 million budget deficit for Fiscal Year 2010-2011 with a Charter obligation to enact a balanced  
15 budget each fiscal year; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Mayor has determined that the state of the City's budget for Fiscal  
17 Year 2010-2011 as indicated herein has created an emergency situation justifying a  
18 Purchaser's award of a contract for food service in Juvenile Hall for the Department of  
19 Juvenile Probation; and,

20 WHEREAS, The Controller's certification, which confirms that said services can be  
21 performed at lower costs to the City and County by private contractor than by employees of  
22 the City and County, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File  
23 No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be part of this resolution as if set forth  
24 fully herein; now, therefore be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's  
 2 certification, and the Mayor's determination of an emergency situation, and approves the  
 3 Proposition J Resolution concerning the Purchaser's award of a contract to a private  
 4 contractor for the services listed below for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.
