

1 [Acceptance of Street for Maintenance]

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3 **Ordinance accepting for purposes of maintenance Peters Avenue, subject to specified**  
4 **limitations, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Section 1806, San**  
5 **Francisco Administrative Code Section 1.52, and DPW Order No. 173,091.**

6 Note: This entire section is new.

7 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

8 Section 1. Findings.

9 (a) The Board of Supervisors has determined that Peters Avenue in the City and  
10 County of San Francisco has not been formally accepted for maintenance purposes.

11 (b) The Board of Supervisors has reviewed and approves the certification and  
12 recommendation of the City Engineer concerning the acceptance of Peters Avenue for  
13 maintenance purposes as contained in Department of Public Works Order No. 173,091, dated  
14 July 23, 2001, a copy of which is in Clerk of the Board of Supervisor’s File No. \_\_\_\_\_.

15 Section 2. Acceptance of Street for Maintenance Purposes.

16 (a) Pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Section 1806, San  
17 Francisco Administrative Code Section 1.52, and Department of Public Works Order No.  
18 173,091, dated July 23, 2001, a copy of which is in Clerk of the Board of Supervisors’ File  
19 No. \_\_\_\_\_ and is incorporated herein by reference, the Board of Supervisors hereby  
20 accepts Peters Avenue from Fair Avenue to the end of Peters Avenue.

21 (b) This street is accepted by the Board subject to the following limitations:

- 22 (1) The portion of street being accepted is the constructed street from back of curb to back of  
23 curb; (2) privately maintained sewers are excluded from acceptance; (3) encroachments that  
24 are permitted, unpermitted, or both are excluded from acceptance; and (4) the acceptance of  
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1 the street does not obviate, amend, alter or in any other way affect existing maintenance  
2 agreements between the City and parties to such maintenance agreements.
