2 AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING
 3 AND TRAFFIC TO APPLY FOR, ^{RETROACTIVELY,} ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT OF \$120,000 OF
 4 FY 1997-98 FEDERAL HAZARD ELIMINATION SAFETY (HES) PROGRAM FUNDS
 5 FOR A GUARDRAIL UPGRADE PROJECT, FOREGOING REIMBURSEMENT OF
 6 INDIRECT COSTS.

 8 WHEREAS, It is the responsibility of the Department of Parking and Traffic to
 9 monitor the traffic safety of San Francisco's roadways and recommend engineering
 10 modifications where safety will be enhanced; and

11
 12 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has identified various
 13 guardrail modifications that will enhance safety in the event of collisions involving
 14 vehicles and guardrails; and

15
 16 WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation awards Federal grant
 17 funds to local agencies through a Hazard Elimination Safety (HES) Program to make
 18 roadway safety improvements; and

19
 20 WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation has awarded the
 21 Department of Parking and Traffic \$120,000 for the 1997/98 Federal Fiscal Year to
 22 upgrade guardrail installations; and



1 WHEREAS, This application has been approved by the San Francisco Parking
2 and Traffic Commission pursuant to its Resolution No. 165-98-PTC adopted August 4,
3 1998, and

5 WHEREAS, Indirect costs may not be funded, according to the State
6 Department of Transportation, which administers these grants; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and
9 Traffic, or his designee, to apply for, retroactively, accept, and expend \$120,000 of FY 1997-98
10 Federal Hazard Elimination Safety (HES) Program funds for a guardrail upgrade project
11 and to execute any and all documents necessary therefore.


