SUBJECT: [Agreement Amendment - Moffatt & Nichol-AGS JV -PRO.0092, Engineering Services for South Ocean Beach Coastal Erosion and Wastewater Infrastructure Protection – Not to Exceed \$12,750,000]

Please see attached a proposed Resolution approving and authorizing the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to execute Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. PRO.0092, Engineering Services for South Ocean Beach Coastal Erosion and Wastewater Infrastructure Protection, with Moffatt & Nichol-AGS Joint Venture, increasing the contract amount by \$7,000,000 for a new total contract amount of \$12,750,000 and increasing the contract duration by six years, staring September 26, 2018 through September 25, 2033, for a new total contract duration of up to 15 years, to continue providing engineering design and support services for the Ocean Beach Climate Change Adaptation Project, pursuant to Section 9.118 of the San Francisco Charter.
