24 25 [Special On-Sale General Liquor License - Verifying Completion of Preapplication Meeting - 3414 Judah Street - La Puesta del Sol Cantina]

Motion verifying that CBTW Inc., doing business as La Puesta del Sol Cantina, located at 3414 Judah Street has completed the preapplication meeting requirement under California Business and Professions Code, Section 23826.13, for the issuance of a new. non-transferable, Type-87 neighborhood-restricted special on-sale general liquor license.

WHEREAS. California Business and Professions Code, Section 23826.13, provides for a new type of affordable, non-transferable liquor license for existing and new restaurants in seven San Francisco neighborhoods as follows: 1) Third Street in Bayview, 2) San Bruno Avenue in Portola, 3) Leland Street and Bayshore in Visitacion Valley, 4) Mission Street in the Excelsior, 5) Ocean Avenue, 6) Taraval Street in the Sunset, and 7) Noriega Street in the Sunset; and

WHEREAS, Five neighborhood-restricted special on-sale general licenses are available in these neighborhoods, to encourage neighborhood activation by reducing storefront vacancies, boost foot traffic, add to the variety of neighborhood-serving small businesses, create good jobs for residents, and provide important spaces for neighbors to meet and socialize; and

WHEREAS, The California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control ("ABC") notified CBTW Inc., located at 3414 Judah Street, that they were selected following a drawing, and may submit a full neighborhood-restricted special on-sale general license application; and

WHEREAS, Prior to submitting such an application, an applicant must conduct a minimum of one preapplication meeting to discuss the application with neighbors and members of the community within the census tract which the premises are located; and

WHEREAS, Applicants must submit to ABC, on form ABC-522-2, signed verification by the local government body that states the applicant has completed the preapplication meeting; and

WHEREAS, CBTW Inc., as required by Business and Professions Code, Section 23826.13, must mail notification of the preapplication meeting at least 14 calendar days before the meeting to all individuals and organizations within a 500-foot radius of the premises for which the license is to be issued; as well as any relevant neighborhood associations for the neighborhood in which the premises is located, as identified on a list maintained by the Planning Department of the City and County of San Francisco; and the Chief of Police for the San Francisco Police Department, as required; and

WHEREAS, CBTW Inc., doing business as La Puesta del Sol Cantina, located at 3414 Judah Street has provided the Board of Supervisors supporting documents, including a copy of the applicant's preapplication meeting notice, a signed preapplication meeting proof of mailing, and meeting minutes or equivalent evidencing completion of the preapplication meeting held on June 28, 2018, at 3223 Ortega Street; and

WHEREAS, These required supporting documents are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 180741; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors verifies that CBTW Inc., doing business as La Puesta del Sol Cantina, located at 3414 Judah Street has completed the preapplication meeting pursuant to California Business and Professions Code, Section 23826.13; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to sign the ABC-522-2 on behalf of the Board of Supervisors verifying CBTW Inc., doing business as La Puesta del Sol Cantina, located at 3414 Judah Street has completed the preapplication meeting.

ABC Type 87 Pre-Application Community Meeting notes

Ortega Branch Library- 3223 Ortega Street, San Francisco, CA.

Date: June 28th 2018, 6;30-7:30

In Attendance: 3 Neighbors, 3 Owners (of Business), Permit Officer Matthew Faliano, and Benjamin Van Houten, BDM-nightlife & entertainment sector.

The Meeting was hosted by myself (John Giuffre), Colin O'Malley, and Brendan O'Brien, all partners of the Restaurant La Puesta del Sol Cantina. We provided background on the Type 87- ABC Liquor License program, our experience in hospitality, and our enthusiasm for the neighborhood as Sunset residents. I also explained to our audience that our goal is to create a restaurant that serves all demographics of the community. We aim to design a space that can be utilized for gatherings, parties, and community events.

Officer Matthew Faliano, the permit officer from the Taraval Police Station, spoke about the Type 87 Program and the ABC application process. He discussed the role of the ALU Unit and his role as a permit officer. He also discussed the liquor license conditions of use process.

The neighbors in attendance brought up several issues and/or concerns that included;

- The potential to expand into the adjacent store front? We responded that it is our goal to eventually buy the property(s). And we have plans for future development to include an art gallery.
- How do we plan to solve the smell that emanates from the two restaurants? We responded that
 along with our due diligence we will make all the appropriate and required changes to the
 restaurant in accordance to all Health Department regulations. We can only solve the issue that
 pertains to our property.
- Will there be entertainment? We have the intention to obtain an Entertainment Permit as this will allow us the option to have live music/ DJ's for weddings or small events. We currently have an Entertainment License and completely understand the responsibility that is required to have one. We assured all our new neighbors that we respect the needs for their privacy and overall comfort.
- Will we see additional traffic implications? We assured our neighbors that there should be no additional impact on traffic in the neighborhood. With the addition of Lyft and Uber, as well as, our proximity to the N Judah train and the 29 Muni bus we our confident that our clientele will use alternative transportation methods.
- We also discussed our desire to eventually add a "Parklet" in front of the restaurant. We believe this will contribute to the community "feel" of the area.

We concluded the meeting with a commitment to running a clean, responsible, and respectable restaurant that will only add value to the surrounding neighborhood. We are always open to communication regarding any issues or concerns.

As part of this Contract which you are voting on, my San Francisco based company has a subcontract with New South Parking – California GP ("New South Parking") to oversee SFO's \$12 million dollar employee parking program. My company will also provide employees and oversight of the Concierge Ambassador Services at SFO's Long Term Parking facility.

Your award of the Contract to New South Parking truly helps to encourage the advancement a San Francisco small WBE/MBE.

I migrated to San Francisco as an undocumented three year old with my family from my home country of El Salvador. I fled a savage civil war which claimed several of my family members.

By the grace of God, hard work, determination, and the help of countless friends, family and organizations like Working Solutions, the Mission Economic Development Agency, and New South Parking, I have been able to fulfill my dream.

Although I still need to have an additional job on top of running my business just to live and be able to raise my two small children in San Francisco, I am optimistic. My future looks bright, especially with the mentorship of New South Parking.

New South Parking assisted me in getting my Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) certification, an important industry accreditation that now allows my firm to bid on other Airport opportunities both in and outside of San Francisco. Further, given NSP's large portfolio of over 100 properties in the Bay Area through its majority partner, SP Plus Corporation, I have been included in - projects outside of this parking contract at SFO. Since 2012, my company has been working at SFO with New South Parking. Over the past six years and through New South Parking's mentorship, my company has grown to manage \$12 million dollars of revenue at SFO; however, it is the countless other things that New South Parking has helped me to learn, such as how to become a union employer, which has enabled my company to provide good union jobs for my staff.

New South Parking has also supported my passion to help my community in the Bayview District with the revitalization of the Arthur Coleman Medical Center. New South Parking has generously contributed to the Center, and gone above and beyond by holding job fairs at the clinic, doing an annual Christmas toy drive in the heart of the Bayview's Oakdale Housing community, and even donating a van to provide access to the clinic for those who are not mobile.
