[Calling for the Creation of the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families

CALLING FOR THE CREATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN, YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES, REQUESTING THE CONTROLLER AND DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES TO MAKE THE APPROPRIATE ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUSTMENTS TO CARRY OUT THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION IMMEDIATELY AND ENSURE A SMOOTH TRANSITION FROM THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF CHILDREN, YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES TO THE NEW DEPARTMENT, AND REQUESTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO MAKE APPROPRIATE ADJUSTMENTS TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

WHEREAS, The City's 1998-1999 budget reflected our commitment to the "Year of the Child" with over \$30 million dedicated for new and enhanced children and youth programs; and

WHEREAS, The 1998-99 budget of the Mayor's Office of Children, Youth and Their Families is \$17,790,816, an increase of \$2.3 million over 1997-98; and

WHEREAS, The City recognizes expanding opportunities for and is committed to providing comprehensive services to San Francisco children, youth and their families; and

WHEREAS, In November 1991, San Francisco voters passed Proposition J, known as the "Children's Amendment," requiring the City to allocate \$.0125 per every \$100 of assessed property tax valuation to fund children's services, which resulted in the establishment of the Mayor's Office of Children, Youth, and Their Families (MOCYF) to promote the development of comprehensive

programs, policies, and planning strategies to enhance services for children, youth, and their families; and

WHEREAS, The City recognizes the importance of the department and seeks to highlight its independence and stature to further strengthen the City's commitment to children, youth and their families; and

WHEREAS, "The Year of the Child" is most appropriately memorialized by the creation of the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby calls for the creation the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller and Director of Human Resources are requested to make the appropriate administrative adjustments to carry out the intent of this resolution immediately and ensure a smooth transition from the Mayor's Office of Children, Youth and Their Families to the new department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Attorney is requested to make appropriate adjustments to the Administrative Code.
