14	Section 1. CEQA Findings.		
15	The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this		
16	ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources		
17	Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
18	Supervisors in File No. 250212 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms		
19	this determination.

21	Section 2. Chapter 94B of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising		
22	Section 94B.4, to read as follows (Sections 94B.1 and a portion of Section 94B.2 reprinted for		
23	informational purposes only):		
24	SEC. 94B.1. DEFINITIONS.		
25	For the purposes of this Chapter 94B, the following definitions shall apply:		

1	(a) "ABC" means the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.
2	(b) "Entertainment Zone" has the meaning set forth in Section 23039.5 of the California
3	Business and Professions Code, as may be amended from time to time.
4	(c) "Entertainment Zone Event" means a special event permitted or licensed by ABC
5	that occurs within the boundaries of an Entertainment Zone established in accordance with
6	this Chapter 94B and within the hours permitted by this Chapter 94B and the Management
7	Plan or the Downtown Activation Permit issued pursuant to Administrative Code Chapter 94D
8	for the Entertainment Zone.
9	(d) "Management Plan" means a plan approved by the Office of Economic and
10	Workforce Development (OEWD) for the management and regulation of Entertainment Zone
11	Events.

13	SEC. 94B.2. ENTERTAINMENT ZONE CONTROLS.
14	* * * *
15	(c) All open alcoholic beverages consumed during an Entertainment Zone Event shall
16	be purchased only from a premises located within the Entertainment Zone that is authorized
17	under California Business and Professions Code Section 23357, 23358, or 23396, as may be
18	amended from time to time, to permit consumers to leave the premises with open containers
19	of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises, or an organization that is authorized
20	by an ABC special event permit or license to make such sales within the Entertainment Zone.

1	(5) Union Street Entertainment Zone.
2	(A) (A) All public streets, public rights-of-way, and sidewalks in front of
3	storefronts-abutting both sides of Union Street, between Gough Street and Steiner Street and abutting
4	both sides of Fillmore Street, between Union Street and Greenwich Street, and all premises
5	specified in Section 94B.2(c) that are adjacent thereto, are hereby designated as the Union Street
6	Entertainment Zone under Sections 23039.5 and 25690 of the California Business and Professions
7	<u>Code.</u>
8	(B) A maximum of two Entertainment Zone Events per calendar year are
9	authorized within the Union Street Entertainment Zone.
10	(B) Notwithstanding subsection (c), if an Entertainment Zone Event
11	within the Union Street Entertainment Zone does not involve the closure of a public street, it
12	need not receive a permit for the use of a public street under Transportation Code Division I,

17	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
18	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
19	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
20	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

22	Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
23	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
24	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal

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### REVISED LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

(9/30/2025, Amended in Board)

[Administrative Code - Union Street Entertainment Zone]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to create the Union Street Entertainment Zone, on Union Street between Gough and Steiner Streets and on Fillmore Street between Union and Greenwich Streets; and affirming the Planning Department's determination under the California Environmental Quality Act.

### **Existing Law**

Under Administrative Code Chapter 94B, open alcoholic beverages can be consumed on any public street, avenue, sidewalk, stairway, alley, or thoroughfare within an Entertainment Zone during an Entertainment Zone Event, subject to state and local law, when those beverages are purchased from a licensed premises within the Entertainment Zone.

As amended by Board File No. 241197, Administrative Code Section 94B.1 defines an Entertainment Zone Event as "an event that occurs within the boundaries of an Entertainment Zone established in accordance with this Chapter 94B and within the hours permitted by this Chapter 94B and the Management Plan or the Downtown Activation Permit issued pursuant to Administrative Code Chapter 94D for the Entertainment Zone." Administrative Code Section 94B.4 establishes Entertainment Zone locations.

### Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would create the Union Street Entertainment Zone on Union Street between Gough and Steiner Streets, and on Fillmore Street between Union and Greenwich Streets.
