WHEREAS, The City of Sacramento is planning to petition the U.S. Supreme Court seeking to overturn the Ninth Circuit's decision; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Sacramento is urging cities throughout California and across the United States to join the petition; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has long been in the forefront in its proactive approach to providing access to individuals with disabilities; and,

WHEREAS, Sidewalk obstructions, as well as cracked and broken sidewalks, may pose significant access and safety problems to persons with a variety of disabilities, including those with mobility and sensory impairments; now, therefore, be it
