3 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, POPULATION HEALTH AND  
4 PREVENTION, COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, TO ACCEPT  
5 RETROACTIVELY AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$96,123 FROM THE  
6 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, SAMHSA, FOR A FAMILY  
7 STRENGTHENING PROJECT AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WHICH DOES  
8 NOT INCLUDE PATENT INFRINGEMENT INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS  
9 CLAUSES; PROVIDING FOR RATIFICATION OF ACTION PREVIOUSLY TAKEN;  
10 WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS.

11 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health, Population Health and Prevention,  
12 Community Mental Health Services, has applied for and been awarded a grant from the  
13 Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services  
14 Administration (SAMHSA) in the amount of \$96,123 for a family strengthening project,  
15 “Kinabukasan”; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SAMHSA requires the City to  
17 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the  
18 Board of Supervisors in File No. 992175 ; and,

19 WHEREAS, SAMHSA has indicated that it will not agree to any modification to the  
20 form of the Agreement; and,

21 WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which  
22 are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; now,  
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to accept  
25 retroactively and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section  
10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive indirect  
costs; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement  
2 contained in Sections 6.21 and 21.19 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an  
3 indemnification of the City by SAMHSA for the infringement of patent rights; and, be it




4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement  
5 contained in Section 6.57 (c) of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include a paragraph  
6 reciting the false claim provisions contained in Section 6.57 (a) of the Administrative Code; and,  
7 be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of  
9 Health to enter into similar agreements with SAMHSA if the grant recurs or is renewed.
