Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 16.302, to read as follows:

SEC. 16.302. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this plan is to extend to employees of the City and County of San Francisco <u>and</u> <u>the Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco</u>, certain benefits which ordinarily accrue from participation in a Deferred Compensation Plan. The City and County of San Francisco does not and cannot represent or guarantee that any particular federal or state income, payroll or other tax consequence will occur by reason of an employee's participation in this plan. The participant should consult with his or her own attorney or other representative regarding all taxes consequences of participation of this plan. (Amended by Ord. 306-80, App. 6/27/80.)
