WHEREAS, Graffiti vandalism is a problem that affects all neighborhoods within San Francisco by contributing greatly to the decline of the quality of urban life; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco currently spends approximately \$10 million per year battling graffiti vandalism; and,

WHEREAS, First-time graffiti vandalism offenders are currently eligible for the Pretrial Diversion Program; and,

WHEREAS, The Pretrial Diversion Program recommends to the court hearing cases of first time offenders that they be assigned twenty-five hours of community service; and

WHEREAS, An increase in the number of hours of community service recommended by the Pretrial Diversion Program would make clear that the City and County of San Francisco is serious about combating graffiti vandalism; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Executive Director of the Pretrial Diversion Program to recommend to the courts at least 50 hours of community service for first time graffiti vandalism offenders.
