WHEREAS, After becoming valedictorian of her class in 1930, she subsequently moved to San Francisco in 1933; and,

WHEREAS, Dolorous MacEachern met her future husband, Kenneth Knight, on her first day in San Francisco and they married ten years later in 1943; and,

WHEREAS, After their marriage they purchased their first and only home in the Excelsior; and,

WHEREAS, Dolorous Knight was an office manager for Foster and Kleiser for 42 years and retired in 1978; and,

WHEREAS, Upon retiring, in order to keep her mind active, Dolorous Knight began making weekly visits to her branch library, the Excelsior Branch Library; and,

WHEREAS, In 1976, Dolorous Knight began keeping a log of the books she read, which now numbers over 2100 books, and a copy of this list now belongs to the San Francisco Public Library; and,

WHEREAS, In July of 2007, at the age of 93, Dolorous Knight suffered a series of small strokes, and her doctors credit her remarkable and speedy recovery in part to the fact that she had been an avid reader for so many years; and,

WHEREAS, Although Kenneth Knight passed away in 2005 after 62 years of marriage, Dolorous Knight continued their lifelong commitment to living simply and saving regularly in order to fulfill their dream of being able to financially support worthy projects in their community; and,

WHEREAS, Dolorous Knight has been an exemplary financial contributor to San Francisco's public libraries, making a large monetary gift in 2006 to her beloved Excelsior Branch Library to help renovate and improve the branch and support programs and services that promote literacy, self-improvement, lifelong learning and neighborhood vitality; and,

WHEREAS, Dolorous Knight's gift to the Excelsior Branch Library represents her love for books, her pleasure and enjoyment as a reader, and her deep commitment to the value of public libraries to individuals and to society; now, therefore, be it
