Resolution urging San Francisco’s Federal legislative delegation to advocate for allocation of HUD McKinney funds at the 2002-03 level to support employment, education and training services to homeless services in San Francisco.

WHEREAS, The Homeless Employment Collaborative is made up of 10 San Francisco-based agencies who work together to provide employment, education and training services to homeless individuals in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The Local Homeless Coordinating Board has established that developing affordable housing will be a local priority for allocation of HUD McKinney funds; and,

WHEREAS, The Homeless Employment Collaborative’s renewal application was reviewed by the McKinney Priority Panel and ranked 28th out of 30 applications due to its focus on employment services; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco is likely to see a decrease in its annual allocation of HUD McKinney funds and an allocation of \$9.3 million would be required to sustain the only employment services dedicated to homeless people; \$14 million to sustain the remainder of McKinney-funded support services; and,

WHEREAS, In recent years, San Francisco has been allocated \$14 million by formula for housing and support services and the alternative source of funding would be San Francisco’s General Fund; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City & County of San Francisco does hereby support employment, education and training services to homeless individuals; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges San Francisco's Federal
2 legislative delegation to advocate that the HUD McKinney funds be allocated at the 2002-03
3 level; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall forward a
5 copy of this resolution to San Francisco's Federal legislative delegation.


