

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Italian American Heritage Day]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to declare the second Monday in October each year to be Italian American Heritage Day in addition to Indigenous Peoples Day.

Existing Law

The City currently refers to the second Monday in October as Indigenous Peoples Day. Until the recent enactment of the Indigenous Peoples Day ordinance, the City referred to the second Monday in October as Columbus Day.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would amend the Administrative Code to recognize the second Monday in October as Italian American Heritage Day in addition to Indigenous Peoples Day. The ordinance would require all official City communications to refer to that day as both Italian American Heritage Day and Indigenous Peoples Day. The proposed ordinance does not affect the recognition or non-recognition of the second Monday in October as a holiday for City departments and employees.
