7	WHEREAS, With the approval of the Board of Supervisors (Board Resolution #754-00),
8	the City, acting through its Public Utilities Commission, on October 4, 2000 entered into a
9	professional services contract not to exceed \$45 million with the San Francisco Water Alliance
10	("SFWA"), a joint venture of Bechtel Infrastructure Corporation (a subsidiary of the Bechtel
11	Corporation), Primus Industries, Inc. (formerly The Jefferson Company), and Jacobs Civil,
12	Inc., a subsidiary of Jacobs Engineering Group (formerly Sverdrup Civil, Inc.) for program
13	management services to support the SFPUC's water, power and sewer capital improvement
14	program, CS-524, Program Management Services, ("Program Management Contract "); and
15	WHEREAS, the PUC and the Board approved the assignment of the remainder of the
16	Program Management Contract to the Water Infrastructure Partners (WIP), a joint venture of
17	the remaining SFWA partners, Primus Industries, Inc. and Jacobs Civil, Inc. (Resolution No.
18	02-0079) after Bechtel Infrastructure Corporation's withdrew from the SFWA; and,
19	WHEREAS, By its terms, the continuation of the Program Management Contract is
20	subject to review by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors on an annual basis provided that
21	WIP's performance during the year has been satisfactory; and
22	WHEREAS, The WIP has met or exceeded second year performance measures,
23	including compliance with MBE and WBE participation goals set by the Human Rights
24	Commission, and compliance with Administrative Code 12.B; and

1	WHEREAS, On December 18, 2002, the PUC by resolution (Resolution No. 02-0269)
2	approved the continuation of the Program Management Contract for Year 3 commencing on
3	December 22, 2002 for a not-to-exceed amount of \$12 million; and
4	WHEREAS, The PUC is separately requesting a supplemental appropriation of \$7
5	million to fund the third year of the Program Management Contract of which \$6 million will be
6	allocated to Program Management Office, and \$1 million will be allocated for SFPUC
7	overhead, including staffing, insurance, equipment, and audit costs; and
8	WHEREAS, On February 11, 2003, the Board approved that the Program Management
9	Contract to continue until February 28, 2003, now, therefore, be it
10	RESOLVED, That the Board hereby approves the continuation of Agreement No.
11	CS-524, Program Management Services, with the Water Infrastructure Partners (WIP) for
12	program management services for the remaining period of the third year.
